Kowtow is dedicated to reducing its ecological footprint, ensuring fair and ethical practices throughout the supply chain, and continually improving its environmental performance. This commitment aligns with the principles of Fairtrade and Global Organic Textiles Standard (GOTS) certifications.

Aim to reduce our carbon footprint in manufacturing and distribution processes.

KEY STRATEGIES AND ACTIONS

Supply Chain Management

- Source all cotton from certified Fairtrade and GOTS producers in India.

- Regularly assess and monitor suppliers for adherence to environmental and ethical standards.

Energy Efficiency

- Aim for use of energy-efficient technologies in manufacturing processes.
- Prioritise renewable energy sources, such as solar or wind power.

Water Management

- Collaborate with suppliers to adopt water-efficient technologies in production.
- Encourage closed-loop water recycling systems where feasible with suppliers.
- Educate employees on water conservation in the supply chain.

- Encourage suppliers to adopt similar waste reduction practices.

Carbon Neutrality

- Encourage employee practices that contribute to carbon reduction.

- Avoid sourcing from areas associated with deforestation or habitat destruction.
