NewLinerTM HD Dry Line Marker Product Manual





Your shipping carton should have:

(1) Handle	Parts Bag Containing:
(1) Bucket & Frame Assembly	(4) 5/16" x 1-1/2" bolts
(1) Gate Control Rod and Lever	(4) 5/16" Nylock nuts
(2) Handle Support Plates	(2) 5/16" Flat Washer
(1) Notched Index Plate	(4)1/4" x 3/4" Bolts
(1) Spring	(9) 1/4" Flat Washers
(2) 1/4" Flat Washers	(4) 1/4" Nylock Nuts
(a) = (a c !! a)	/4\ C ++ B'

(3) 5/16" Nylock Nuts (1) Cotter Pin

Tools Required: (2) 1/2" Wrenches, (1) Pliers



ASSEMBLY:

1. Remove the unit from the box and place it on a flat surface.

Note: The axles should be on the underside of the frame. If they are not, lift the frame and swing the bucket around to the other side. The handle/bucket support should be facing the end of the frame with the cutouts for the handle assembly.

- 2. Lay the handle assembly behind the unit with the foam grips down and the bottom of the handle towards the unit.
- 3. Mount operating lever and notched plate to handle assembly. (Pic 1.)
- 4. Attach the handle to the rear of the frame using two bolts and Nylock nuts. Do not tighten the nuts fully at this time.
- 5. Rotate the handle upward so the upper holes in the handle align with the holes in the handle/bucket support braces.
- 6. Attach the gate control rod to the powder gate using one $\frac{1}{4}$ " flat washer and cotter pin. Control lever should be above the handle.




OPERATION:

- 1. Place powder gate control lever in OFF position. (Pull out on operating lever to move between notches.)
- 2. Fill the Dry Liner with any type dry-line marking material. NOTE: Make sure marking material is kept dry.
- 3. Position Dry Liner over line to be marked.
- 4. Select line width by moving powder gate control lever to the 2" or 4" position.
- 5. Begin walking. Material will feed from the bottom center of the box as you walk until the box is empty or the control lever is moved to the CLOSED position.
- 6. Rinse box after each use with water. Allow to air dry.

- 1. Place the notched plate (1), on pivot stud with the lettering facing outward.
- 2. Center the two tabs (2), over the handle (A). Secure the plate on the stud with one nylock nut (3). Tighten the nut.
- 3. Place the lever (5) on the stud. (The lever should bend in towards the plate with operating rod on outside of lever.) Secure the lever on the stud with one washer, one spring, one washer, and one nylock nut. (4)

*** Tighten the outside nylock nut until spring just begins to compress. (DO NOT TIGHTEN ALL THE WAY)

Insert large end of handle support (triangle piece, long side down) to the bucket with bolts, washers and nuts.



Tab end of handle supports goes on inside of the handle on the 50 Ib. (Washer against the support, see picture)




Tab end of handle supports goes on outside of handle on the 100 lb. (Washer against the support, see picture)





For service under this warranty, buyer shall ship the defective part or parts of the equipment, transportation prepaid, to Newstripe, Inc. together with a written description of any claimed defect and proof of purchase date of the materials being returned. **Prior to retuning any part or machine, the CUSTOMER must obtain a Return Materials Authorization number. In no event shall Newstripe, Inc. be liable for incidental or consequential damages and no person had any authority to bind it to any representation or warranty, not be responsible for work done, materials furnished or repairs made by others without its' specific written authorization.

IT IS EXPRESSLY AGREED THAT THIS WARRANTY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE ADJUSTMENT, REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF PARTS AND THE LABOR AND SERVICES REQUIRED THEREBY. IN NO EVENT, INCLUDING ANY CLAIM FOR NEGLIGENCE, SHALL NEWSTRIPE, INC. BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.
