## Recommended:

Sand and finish customer supplied wood planks to reduce sharp edges, slivers and extend life.

1. Attach the Rubber Feet (H) to the Leg Assemblies (A) with 3/8" x 1 1/2"Hex Bolts (C), 3/8" Flat Washers (E), 3/8" Lock Washers (F) and 3/8"Hex Nuts (D).

2. Insert the Plastic Tube Plugs (G) in all open tube ends on the Leg Assemblies (A). See Figure 1.

## Notice:

For best results this player bench should be assembled on a flat and level surface.
3. Position Leg Assemblies (A) 76" apart. Clamp one 2" X 10" X 16' Wooden Plank (I) to the seat portion of Leg Assemblies (A) with approximately 20" extending from each end of Leg Assembly (A). Make sure the Leg Assemblies (A) are perpendicular to the 2" X 10" X 16' Wooden Plank (I). Clamp the second 2" X 10 " $X$ 16' Wooden Plank (I) to the back rest area of the Leg Assemblies (A) with approximately 20 " extending from each end. See Figure 2.

4. Using the mounting holes in the Leg Assembly (A) as a guide to drill through the 2" X 10 " $X 16$, Wooden Plank (I) with a 3/8" drill bit. Use the 3/8" X 4" Carriage Bolts (B), 3/8" Lock Washer (F) and $3 / 8$ " Hex Nuts (D) to secure the 2 " X 10 " X 16 ’ Wooden Plank (I) to the Leg Assemblies (A).
