

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut eight 1 1/2" strips. (Cornerstones)

From Fabric B:

- 1. Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut eight 2 1/4" strips for binding.

From Fabric C:

- 1. Cut one 9 1/2" strip. Subcut four 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 10" strip. Subcut one 9 1/2" square, and twelve 5" squares from remaining fabric. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut two 9 1/2" strips. Subcut five 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 9 1/2" strips. Subcut five 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut two 9 1/2" strips. Subcut six 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric G:

- 1. Cut two 5" strips. Subcut twelve 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 9 1/2" strips. Subcut three 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric H:

1. Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric I:

1. Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric J:

 Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty-four 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric K:

1. Cut one 9 1/2" strip. Subcut three 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric L:

1. Cut one 9 1/2" strip. Subcut one 9 1/2" squares and four 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric M:

- 1. Cut one 5" strip. Subcut eight 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 9 1/2" strip. Subcut two 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric N:

- 1. Cut ten 1 1/2" strips. (Cornerstones)
- 2. Cut seven 9 1/2" strips. Subcut seventy-one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing Rectangles)
- 3. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

Piecing Instructions:

Pieced Blocks:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 5" Fabric 1 square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of one 9 1/2" Fabric 2 square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with three additional 5" Fabric 1 squares at the remaining corners of the same Fabric 2 square to complete one block. (Figure 1)

Cornerstones:

 Sew two 1 1/2" N strips to the opposite long sides of one 1 1/2" A strip to make a strip set. Make a total of four strip sets. Subcut eighty-four unit A at 1 1/2" intervals. (Figure 2)

2. Sew two 1 1/2" A strips to the opposite long sides of one 1 1/2" N strip to make a strip set. Make a total of two strip sets. Subcut forty-two unit B at 1 1/2" intervals. (Figure 3)

Make 42.

 Sew together two unit A and one unit B to make a cornerstone. Cornerstone measures 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of forty-two cornerstones. (Figure 4)

Quilt Assembly: Refer to Quilt Diagram.

- 1. Refer to quilt diagram for block placement guide, arrange and sew five pieced blocks and six 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" N rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of six pieced rows.
- 2. Sew together six cornerstones and five 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" N rectangles to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of seven pieced sashing rows.
- 3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.
- 4. Sew two 2 1/2" x 75 1/2" N strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" N strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with vertical seam/s. Press seams open and trim to 75" x 87".
- Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- 5. Join eight 2 1/4" B binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.
