## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut eight $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Cornerstones)

From Fabric B:

1. Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut eight 2 1/4" strips for binding.

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut one $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four $91 / 2$ " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one 10 " strip. Subcut one $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, and twelve 5 " squares from remaining fabric. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric D:
3. Cut two $91 / 2 "$ strips. Subcut five $91 / 2$ " squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 9 1/2" strips. Subcut five 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut two $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut six $91 / 2$ " squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric G:

1. Cut two 5" strips. Subcut twelve 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one 9 1/2" strips. Subcut three 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric H:

1. Cut three 5 " strips. Subcut twenty 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric I:

1. Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric J:
2. Cut three 5" strips. Subcut twenty-four 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric K:
3. Cut one $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut three $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric L:

1. Cut one $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut one $91 / 2$ " squares and four 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric M:

1. Cut one 5 " strip. Subcut eight 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one 9 1/2" strip. Subcut two 9 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric $\mathbf{N}$ :

1. Cut ten $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Cornerstones)
2. Cut seven 9 1/2" strips. Subcut seventy-one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing Rectangles)
3. Cut eight $21 / 2 "$ strips. Piece strips and subcut two 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

## Piecing Instructions:

## Pieced Blocks:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 5" Fabric 1 square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of one 9 1/2" Fabric 2 square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with three additional 5" Fabric 1 squares at the remaining corners of the same Fabric 2 square to complete one block. (Figure 1)

## Cornerstones:

1. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$ strips to the opposite long sides of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strip to make a strip set. Make a total of four strip sets. Subcut eighty-four unit A at $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ intervals. (Figure 2)

Make 84.
2. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} A$ strips to the opposite long sides of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$ strip to make a strip set. Make a total of two strip sets. Subcut forty-two unit B at $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ intervals. (Figure 3)

## Make 42.

3. Sew together two unit $A$ and one unit $B$ to make a cornerstone. Cornerstone measures 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of forty-two cornerstones. (Figure 4)

## Quilt Assembly: Referto Quilt Diagram.

1. Refer to quilt diagram for block placement guide, arrange and sew five pieced blocks and six $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$ rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of six pieced rows.
2. Sew together six cornerstones and five $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$ rectangles to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of seven pieced sashing rows.
3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.
4. Sew two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 751 / 2^{\prime \prime} N$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two $21 / 2$ " x $671 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with vertical seam/s. Press seams open and trim to $75^{\prime \prime} \times 87^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join eight $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} B$ binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.
