## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with $1 / 4$ " seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## Fabric A:

- Cut (1) 34 1/2" x 42 1/2"

Fabric B:

- Cut (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip; cut (4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Fabric C:

- Cut (6) 2 1/4" x WOF strips; sew together end to end using diagonal seams and set aside as binding


## Fabric D:

- Cut (5) 1 7/8" x WOF strips; cut (100) $17 / 8$ " x $17 / 8$ " squares


## Fabric E:

- Cut (4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips; cut (2) 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" borders and (2) 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" borders
Fabric F and G:
- Cut (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips

Fabric H:

- Cut (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sew together end to end and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" borders and (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" borders


## Fabric l:

- Cut (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips
- Cut (10) 1 7/8" x WOF strips; cut (200) 1 7/8" x $17 / 8$ " squares sub cut on the diagonal into (400) triangles

## Piecing Instructions:

The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) F, G, and (2) J $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip together with (4) Fabric I $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips as shown to make a strip set. Make 3 strip sets. Cut (26) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ 1/2" pieced rectangles from the strip sets.

2. Sew (6) pieced rectangles together with (2) Fabric B squares into the horizontal borders. Sew (7) strip sets together into the vertical borders. Make (2) of each border. Set aside for now.

3. Sew a pair of Fabric I $17 / 8$ " triangles to opposite sides of the Fabric D 1 7/8" squares. Press, then sew another pair of Fabric I $17 / 8$ " triangles to the remaining sides. Trim and square to $21 / \mathbf{2 ' ~}^{\prime \prime}$ x 2 1/2" to make an A Unit. Make (100) A Units.

4. Sew (24) A Units together into the horizontal borders. Sew (26) A Units together into the vertical borders. Make (2) of each border.

5. Sew all the border strips to the Fabric A panel in the order shown in the layout diagram. Sew the vertical borders first, press, then sew the horizontal borders and press, to make the quilt top.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim backing to 64 " $\times 72$ ".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
5. Join Fabric C $21 / 4$ " binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
