

## Quilt Yardages:

Fabric C	PMAG 5362 B	1/2 yard
Fabric D	PMAG 5364 E	3/8 yard
Fabric E	PMAG 5364 K	5/8 yard
Fabric F	PMAG 5364 LO	1/4 yard
Fabric G	PMAG 5364 O	1/4 yard
Fabric H	PMAG 5365 BV	1/2 yard
Fabric I	PMAG 5365 K	1 1/4 yards
Fabric J	PMAG 5365 O	3/8 yard
Backing		3 1/2 yards

## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

#### Fabric A:

• Cut (1) 34 1/2" x 42 1/2"

#### Fabric B:

Cut (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip; cut (4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

#### Fabric C:

 Cut (6) 2 1/4" x WOF strips; sew together end to end using diagonal seams and set aside as binding

#### Fabric D:

 Cut (5) 1 7/8" x WOF strips; cut (100) 1 7/8" x 17/8" squares

#### Fabric E:

 Cut (4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips; cut (2) 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" borders and (2) 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" borders

#### Fabric F and G:

Cut (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips

#### Fabric H:

 Cut (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sew together end to end and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" borders and (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" borders

#### Fabric I:

- Cut (12) 1 1/2" x WOF strips
- Cut (10) 1 7/8" x WOF strips; cut (200) 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" squares sub cut on the diagonal into (400) triangles

#### Fabric J:

• Cut (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips

## Piecing Instructions:

The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.


**1.** Sew (1) F, G, and (2) J 1 1/2" x WOF strip together with (4) Fabric I 1 1/2" x WOF strips as shown to make a strip set. Make 3 strip sets. Cut (26) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieced rectangles from the strip sets.

Sew (6) pieced rectangles together with (2) Fabric B squares into the horizontal borders. Sew (7) strip sets together into the vertical borders. Make (2) of each border. Set aside for now.



**VERTICAL BORDER** 


Sew a pair of Fabric I 1 7/8" triangles to opposite sides of the Fabric D 1 7/8" squares. Press, then sew another pair of Fabric I 1 7/8" triangles to the remaining sides. Trim and square to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" to make an A Unit. Make (100) A Units.


**4.** Sew (24) A Units together into the horizontal borders. Sew (26) A Units together into the vertical borders. Make (2) of each border.



**5.** Sew all the border strips to the Fabric A panel in the order shown in the layout diagram. Sew the vertical borders first, press, then sew the horizontal borders and press, to make the guilt top.

## Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing using two widths with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim backing to 64" x 72".
- **2.** Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- **4.** Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- **5.** Join Fabric C 2 1/4" binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
