## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Background:

1. Cut two 1" strips. Subcut ten 1 " $\times 6$ " rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut three 2 1/2" strips. Subcut twenty 2 1/2" squares and ten 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
3. Cut two 5 " strips. Subcut ten 5 " x 6 " rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
4. Cut nine $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from four strips. Subcut forty $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles from remaining five strips. (Sashing)
5. Cut five $21 / 2$ " strips. Piece strips and subcut two 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" and two 2 1/2" x 51 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut one 22 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle, centering design. (Quilt Center)
From Fabric B:
2. Cut one 5 " strip. Subcut two 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
3. Cut six $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece strips and subcut two $31 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ and two 3 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)
4. Cut one $5^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut two 5 " squares and two 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut one 5" strip. Subcut two 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut two 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut one 5" strip. Subcut two 5 " squares. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric G:
2. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric H:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut two $21 / 2$ " $\times 8$ 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric I:

1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips. Subcut four 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips.

From Fabric J:

1. Cut two 1 " strip. Subcut ten 1 " $\times 51 / 2$ " rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut four 1 1/2" strips. Subcut forty 1 1/2" x 4 " rectangles. (Sashing)
From Fabric K:
3. Cut one $21 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut two $21 / \mathbf{2 " ~}^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric L:

1. Cut one 5" strip. Subcut two 5" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut seven 2 1/4" strips. (Binding)

## Piecing Instructions:

## Pieced Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 5 " Fabric 1 square. Place square, right sides together, at bottom left corner of one 5" x 6" Background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Sew one 1" x 6" Background rectangle to the bottom of sewn unit. (Figure 1)

From Fabric C :
2. Add one 1 " $\times 5$ 1/2" J rectangle and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ 1/2" Background rectangle to the left of step 1 unit, as shown. (Figure 2)

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background square. Place square, at a corner of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 2 rectangle as shown in Figure 3. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle. (Figure 3)

4. Sew step 2 unit on top of step 3 unit to make complete one pieced block. Block measures 8 1/2" (horizontal) x 7 1/2" (vertical) unfinished. (Figure 4)

5. Sew a total of two blocks each for the following Fabric $1 /$ Fabric 2 combinations. Note the four blocks that are made as mirror-imaged blocks. (Figure 5)

## Quilt Assembly:

1. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ I strips to the opposite long sides of one 22 1/2" x 40 1/2" A rectangle, followed by two 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Background strips.
2. Sew together twenty $11 / 2 \times 4$ " Background rectangles and twenty $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " J rectangles to make a pieced row, alternating. Add one 1 1/2" $\times 40$ 1/2" Background strip to the top of pieced row. Make a total of two row sections. Refer to quilt image and sew to the top and bottom of step 1 section.
3. Refer to quilt image for block placement guide, arrange and sew together five pieced blocks to make a row unit. Add one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ I strip to the bottom.
4. Inner border. Sew two 2 1/2" x 51 1/2" Background strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
5. Outer border. Sew two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 551 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim backing to 58 " x 69".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
5. Join seven 2 1/4" L binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.


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
