Yardages:

Fabric A: **SUED 300 N** 3 yards
 Fabric B: **BOHE 205 MU** 1 3/4 yards
 Fabric C: **BOHE 206 MU** 5/8 yard
 Fabric D: **BOHE 208 MU** 7/8 yard
 Fabric E: **BOHE 207 MU** 7/8 yard
 Fabric F: **BOHE 208 B** 5/8 yard
 Backing of choice: 3 3/4 yards
 Batting 66" x 82"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut seventeen 4 1/2" strips. Sub-cut into one hundred fifty 4 1/2" squares.
2. Cut six 1 1/2" strips for Border 1.
3. Cut seven 2 1/4" strips for binding.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut three 8 1/2" strips. Sub-cut three 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles, five 8 1/2" squares, and one 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle.
2. Cut seven 4 1/2" strips for Border 2.

From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 8 1/2" strips. Sub-cut into two 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles, six 8 1/2" squares, and one 8-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.

From Fabric D:

1. Cut three 8 1/2" strips. Sub-cut into three 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and five 8-1/2" squares.

From Fabric E:

1. Cut three 8 1/2" strips. Sub-cut into three 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and five 8-1/2" squares.

From Fabric F:

1. Cut two 8 1/2" strips. Sub-cut into four 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles, three 8 1/2" squares, and one 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle.

Piecing Instructions:

A. Block 1

1. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the one hundred fifty 4 1/2" A squares.
2. Place one 4 1/2" A square, right sides together, on each corner of one 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press towards the triangles. Block should measure 8 1/2" x 12 1/2". (Figure 1).
3. Make three of each: B, D, and E. Make two: C. Make four: F

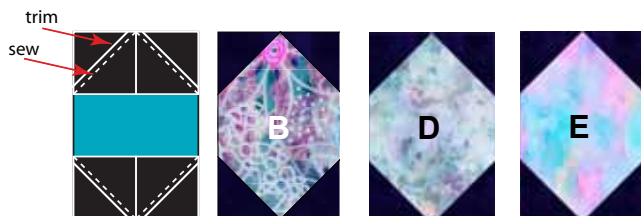

B. Block 2

1. Place one 4 1/2" A square, right sides together, on each corner of one 8 1/2" square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press towards the triangles. Block should measure 8 1/2" square. (Figure 2).
2. Make four of each: B, C, and E. Make three of each: D and F.

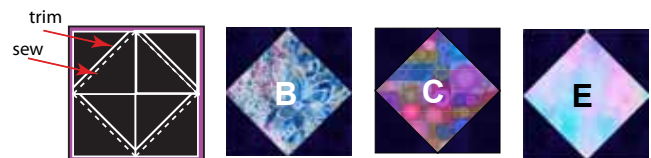
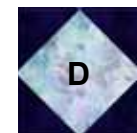

C. Block 3

1. Place one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " A square, right sides together, on two corners of one $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press towards the triangles. Block should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. (Figure 3).
2. Make one of each: B and E. Make two of each: C and D.

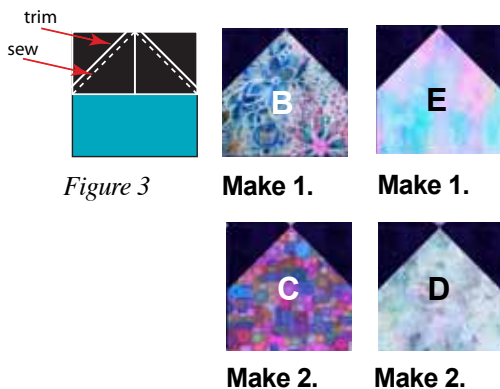

D. Block 4

1. Place one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " A square, right sides together, on two corners of one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press towards the triangles. Block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". (Figure 4).
2. Make one of each: B, C, and F.

Quilt Assembly: Refer to Quilt Diagram.

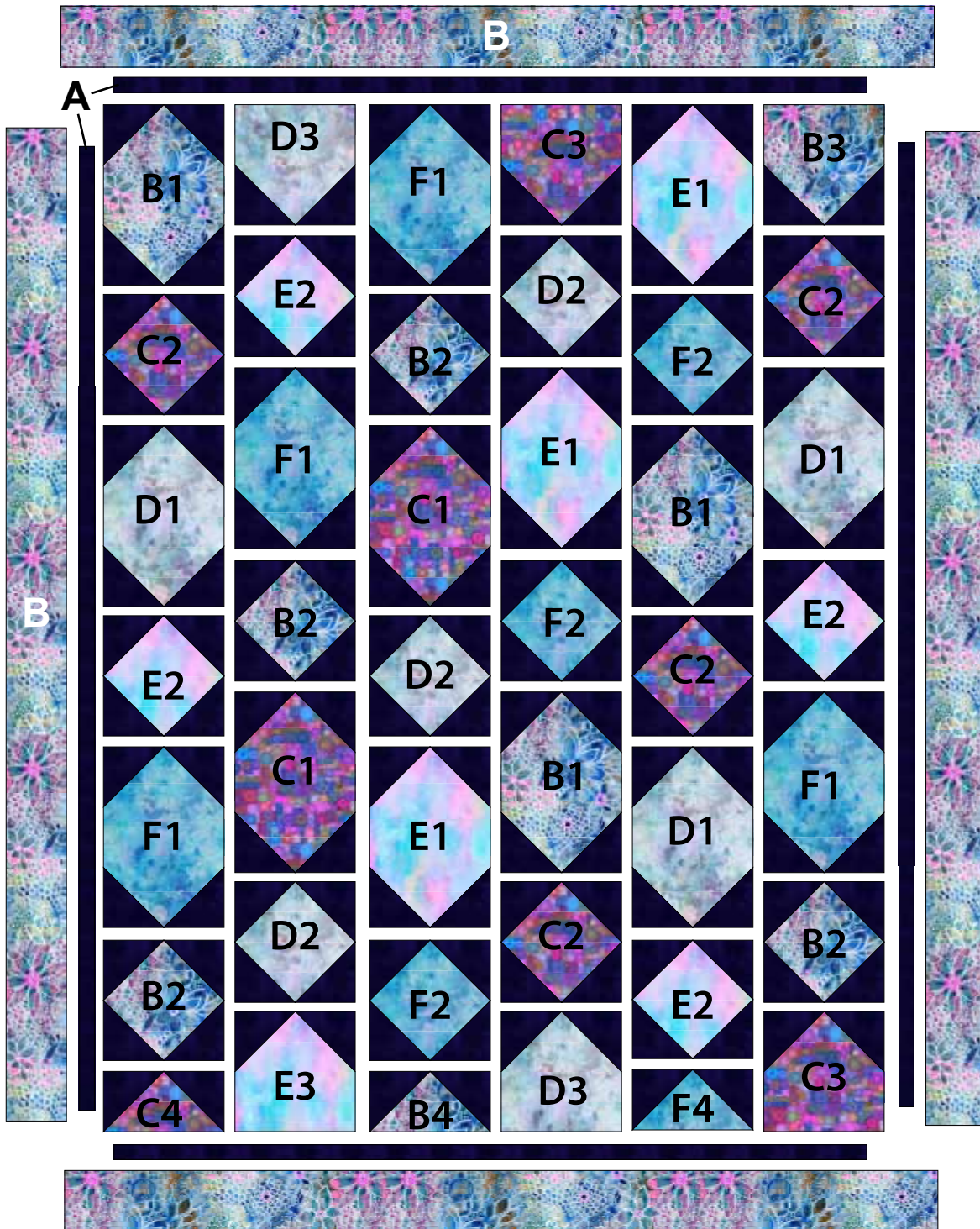
1. Following the Quilt Diagram, place Blocks 1, 2, 3 and 4 in vertical (up and down) strips.
2. Sew vertical strips together and press seams open to reduce bulk.
3. Sew vertical rows together. Press seams open.

Borders

4. Sew six $1\frac{1}{2}$ " A strips together with diagonal seams. Press seams open.
5. Measure through the vertical center of the quilt and trim two strips to this length. Match centers and sides, pin and sew to sides of the quilt. Press to border.
6. Measure through the horizontal center and trim two strips to this width. Match centers and sides, pin and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press to border.
7. Repeat steps 4-6 with seven $4\frac{1}{2}$ " B strips.

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing with horizontal seams to measure 66 " x 82 ". Press seam open.
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with top.
5. Join seven $2\frac{1}{4}$ " A binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method. **Tip:** Lay binding on the quilt before sewing to make sure that the binding seams do not meet any of the corners.
6. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.
