## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. LOF = length of fabric. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

Quilt

1. Cut four $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares centering the kitties in circles within each square.
2. Cut one $121 / 2$ " square centering the kitties in chairs within the square.
Pillow
3. Cut $1 / 4$ " to the outside of the narrow navy frame. This should be 9 1/4" x 15 3/4".

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut four $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF strips centering the border motif area within each strip. Trim strips to $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2$ " centering motifs as you choose.

## From Fabric C:

## Quilt

1. Cut two $37 / 8 "$ strip; subcut sixteen $37 / 8$ " squares. Cut once on the diagonal to make thirty-two triangles.
2. Cut one $31 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strip; subcut eight $31 / 2$ " squares.
3. Cut four $27 / 8$ " strips; subcut sixty-four $27 / 8$ " squares. Cut once on the diagonal to make one hundred twentyeight triangles.
4. Cut eleven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.Use five strips to cut four 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" strips and thirty-two 2 1/2" squares. Sew remaining six strips together end-to-end. Press seams open. Cut two 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" and two 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.

## Pillow

5. Cut two $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut two $15 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
6. Cut one 2 3/8" strip. Subcut two 2 3/8" x 10 1/4" strips.

From Fabric D:

1. Cut one $67 / 8$ " strip; subcut four $67 / 8$ " squares. Cut once on the diagonal to make eight triangles.
2. Cut two $27 / 8$ " strips; subcut thirty-two $27 / 8$ " squares. Cut once on the diagonal to make sixty-four triangles.
3. Cut four 2 1/2" strips; subcut four 2 1/2" $\times 24$ 1/2" strips.

From Fabric E :

1. Cut four 2 1/2" strips; subcut four 2 1/2" $\times 24$ 1/2" strips.

From Fabric F:
Quilt

1. Cut two $47 / 8$ " strips; subcut sixteen $47 / 8$ " squares, cut once on the diagonal in make thirty-two triangles.
2. Cut one $37 / 8$ " strip; subcut eight $37 / 8$ " squares, cut once on the diagonal in make sixteen triangles.
Pillow
3. Cut two 1" strips; subcut two 1" x 9 1/4" strips and two 1 " x 16 3/4" strips.
4. Cut one 12 1/2" strip; subcut two $121 / 2$ " x 14 " rectangles.

From Fabric G:

1. Cut four 2 1/2" strips; subcut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
2. Cut seven 3 1/2" strips. Sew end-to-end. Press seams open. Cut two 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" and two 3 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips.
From Fabric H :
3. Cut on the diagonal to create 350" of $21 / 4$ " bias binding.

## Quilt Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" B rectangles, and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C, D, E, and $G$ rectangles together as shown in Figure 1 to make four A Units. Press. Set aside.

2. Sew one $37 / 8 " \mathrm{C}$ triangle to one $37 / 8 \mathrm{~F} \mathrm{~F}$ triangle to make a square (Figure 2). Trim to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Press. Make sixteen.

3. Sew two HST from step 2 with two 3 1/2" C squares to make one B Unit (Figure 3). Press. Make four B Units.

4. Sew remaining HST from step 2 with two $37 / 8$ " C triangles as shown in Figure 4. Press. Sew on one $67 / 8$ " D triangle. Trim to $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2". Press. Sew together in pairs as shown to make four $C$ Units. Press.

Make 4.
5. Repeat steps $2-4$ using 2 7/8" C triangles, 2 1/2" C squares, $27 / 8$ " D triangles, and $47 / 8$ " $F$ triangles to make sixteen D Units and sixteen E Units as shown in Figure 5. Trim to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".

6. Sew B and C units to the $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A square as shown in Figure 6 to make Block A. Press. Trim to 24 1/2" x 24 1/2".

7. Sew $D$ and $E$ units to the $81 / 2$ "x $81 / 2$ " A squares as shown in Figure 7. Press. Trim to 16 1/2" x 16 1/2". Make four of Block B.

## Quilt Assembly: (refer to Quilt Diagram)

1. Sew A Units, Block A, and Block B together as shown to make the quilt top. Press.
2. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2$ " C strip to opposite sides of the quilt. Press toward strip.
3. Sew one 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" C strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward strip.
4. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime} G$ strip to opposite sides of the quilt. Press toward strip.
5. Sew one 3 1/2" x 66 1/2" G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward strip.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing to measure 74" square with a vertical seam. Press seam open.
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with top.
5. Join 2 1/4" H bias binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method. Save remaining binding for pillows.
6. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.

## Pillow Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew one 1" $\times 9$ 1/4" F strip to both sides of the A panel block. Press toward the block. Sew one 1" x 16 3/4" strip to the top and bottom of the block; press (Figure 1).
2. Sew one $23 / 8$ " x 10 1/4" C strip to both sides of the block. Press toward the block. Sew one 2 3/8" x 20 1/2" C strip to the top and bottom of the block; press (Figure 2).
3. Make a quilt sandwich using batting and muslin or scrap fabric (it won't show when pillow is complete). Quilt as desired. Note that this step can be eliminated if you prefer not to quilt the pillow top.
4. Fold one long raw edge of each $121 / 2$ " $\times 14$ " F rectangles under and then again; press. Stitch to hold double fold in place. Layer these pieces with the pillow top with all wrong sides together. The stitched edges of the backing rectangles will overlap. Pin and baste around outer edge.
5. Using the remaining $21 / 4$ " H bias binding strip, sew it to the front of the pillow top. Turn the binding to the back and
 secure in place by hand or machine. Insert a 12" x 20" pillow form and enjoy!
