## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut fifteen 3 1/2" strips; subcut thirty-six 3 1/2" $\times 9$ 1/2" rectangles and thirty-six $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. (Blocks)
From Fabric B:
2. Cut five 5 " strips; subcut thirty-six 5 " squares. (Blocks)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut seven 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open and cut pieced strip into two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (2nd Border)
2. Cut eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Binding)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut eighteen $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut thirty-six $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ 1/2" rectangles and thirty-six 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
2. Cut eleven 2" strips; subcut thirty-six 2 " $\times 5$ " rectangles and thirty-six 2 " $\times 61 / 2$ " rectangles. (Blocks)
3. Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open and cut pieced strip into two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips. (1st Border)
4. Cut seven $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open and cut pieced strip into two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two 3 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips. (3rd Border)

## Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew one 2" $\times 5$ " D rectangle to the left side of one 5 " B square. Note position of the print in the $B$ square. Press toward D.
2. Sew one 2" $x 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ rectangle to the top of the Step 1 unit. Press toward D.
3. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A rectangle to the left of the Step 2 unit. Press toward $A$.
4. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A rectangle to the top of the Step 2 unit. Press toward A.
5. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ rectangle to the left of the Step 3 unit. Press toward D.
6. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ rectangle to the top of the Step 3 unit. Press toward D.
7. Repeat steps to make thirty-six blocks (Figure 1).

## Quilt Assembly:

1. Refer to Quilt Diagram to lay blocks into rows. Sew rows and press seams in opposite directions from row to row or press seams open.
2. Sew rows together and press.
3. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ strip to both sides of the Quilt Center. Press toward D. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center; press.
4. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{C}$ strip to both sides of the Quilt Center. Press toward C. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 2^{\prime \prime} C$ strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center; press.
5. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ strip to both sides of the Quilt Center. Press toward D. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ D strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center; press.

## Finishing:

1. Sew two widths of backing fabric together. Press seams open. Trim backing to 80 " $\times 80$ ".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
5. Join eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} C$ binding strips with diagonal seams.

Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
