## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF; perpendicular to slevages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Fussy-cut five 11 1/4" x 14 1/4" vertical images (A1).
2. Fussy-cut five 14 1/4" x 11 1/4" horizontal images (A2).

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut three 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut ten 8 1/2" squares (B1).
2. Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut forty 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (B2).
From Fabric C:
3. Cut twenty-six 2 1/2" $x$ WOF strips. NOTE: To minimize waste and make the best use of these strips, you can cut one C1, one C2 and one C3 from one strip until all the required $C 1$ and $C 2$ rectangles are cut.
a. Cut ten 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles (C1).
b. Cut ten 2 1/2" x 14 1/4" rectangles (C2).
c. Cut forty 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (C3).
d. Sew eight strips together into one long strip.
i. Cut two 2 1/2" x 86 1/2" Outer Border strips (C4).
ii. Cut two 2 1/2" x 73" Outer Border strips (C5).
4. Cut two $161 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub cut thirty-one 2" x 16 1/2" sashing strips (C6).
5. Cut one $13 / 4$ " x WOF strip. Sub cut ten 1 3/4" x 3 1/2" rectangles (C7).
6. Cut five $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
a. Cut ten 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips (C8).
b. Cut ten 1 1/2" x 1 3/4" rectangles (C9).

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut three $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub cut forty $27 / 8 "$ squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to make eighty triangles (D1).
2. Cut five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub cut eighty 2 1/2" squares (D2).
3. Cut one 2" x WOF strip. Sub cut twelve 2" squares (D3).
4. Cut seven $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips.
a. Cut ten 1 3/4" x 14 1/2" rectangles (D4).
b. Cut ten $13 / 4 " \times 101 / 4$ " rectangles (D5).
5. Cut nine $21 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips for binding (D6).

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut three $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub cut forty $27 / 8$ " squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to make eighty triangles (E1).
2. Cut five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub cut eighty 2 1/2" squares (E2).

## Piecing Instructions:

## Block A (Figure 1)

1. Sew one C7 and one D5 rectangle together to make a C7-D5 unit. Press.
2. Sew one C9 and one D4 rectangle together to make a C9-D4 unit. Press.
3. Sew one C2 to the left side of an A1 rectangle. Press.
4. Sew one C7-D5 unit to


Figure 1 Make 5. the bottom of the A1-C2 block. Press.
5. Sew one C9-D4 unit to the right side of the block. Press.
6. Sew one C 8 to the bottom of the block. Press.
7. Sew one C 1 to the right side to complete one block $A$. Press. It should measure 16 1/2" square.
8. Repeat steps 1-7 to make five Block A total.

Block B (Figure 2)

1. Sew one C7 and one D5 rectangle together to make a C7-D5 unit. Press.
2. Sew one C9 and one D4 rectangle together to make a C9-D4 unit. Press.
3. Sew one C2 to the top side of an A2 rectangle. Press.
4. Sew one C7-D5 unit to the right side of the A2-C2 block. Press.

5. Sew one C9-D4 unit to the bottom of the block. Press.
6. Sew one C 8 to the right side of the block. Press.
7. Sew one C1 to the bottom to complete one block B. Press. It should measure 16 1/2" square.
8. Repeat steps 1-7 to make five Block B total.

## Block C

1. Sew one E1 and one D1 triangles together to make
 an ED Half-Square Triangle unit (Figure 3). Press. Figure 3 Make eight ED units.

Make 8.
2. Sew two ED units and one B2 rectangle together to make an EDB strip (Figure 4). Press.
3. Sew one C3 rectangle to one side of an EDB strip to make an EDBC unit (Figure 5). Press. Make four EDBC units.

Make 4.
4. Sew two D2 and two E2 squares together into one DE 4-Patch unit (Figure 5). Press. Make four $D E$ units.
5. Lay out one B1, four DE and four EDBC units as shown (Figure 6). Sew units within each row together. Press. Then, sew rows together

Quilt Assembly: Refer to Quilt Diagram

1. Layout five Block A, five Block B and ten Block C with C6 sashing strips and D3 cornerstones.
2. Sew units within each row together. Press. Then, sew rows together to complete the quilt center. Press.
3. Sew one C4 Outer Border strip to each of the side edges of the quilt center. Press.
4. Sew one C5 Outer Border strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt. Press.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths with a vertical seam. Press seams open. Trim to 80" x 98".
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
5. Join 2 1/4" D6 binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt. to complete one Block C. Press. It should measure 16 1/2" square.
7. Repeat steps 1-5 to make ten Block C total.
