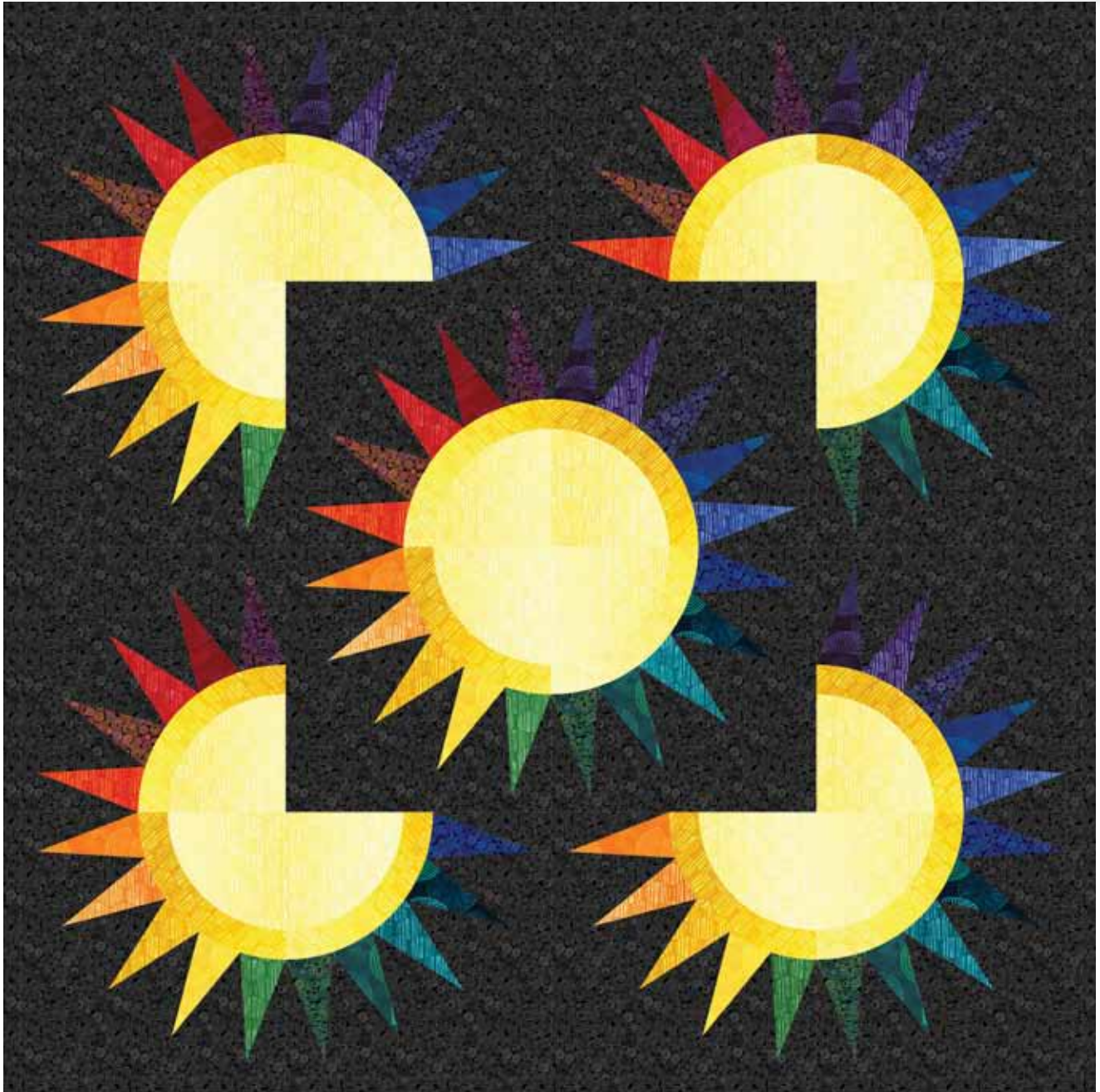
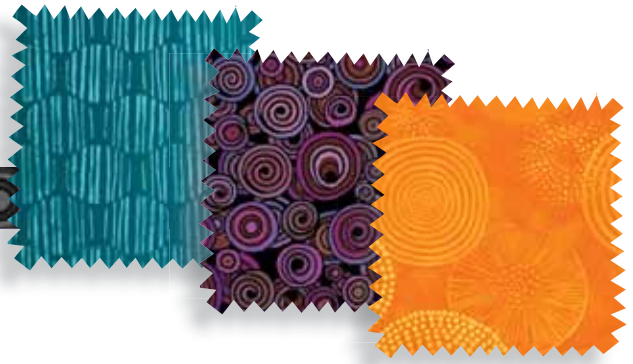

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A, B, C, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, Q, R, and S cut:

- Four 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles from the DARK side.

From Fabric D, cut:

- Thirteen 5 1/2" WOF strips; subcut sixty-four 5 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles.
- Seven 3 1/4" x WOF; subcut thirty-two 3 1/4" x 7" rectangles.
- Seven 2 1/4" x WOF for Binding.
- Sixteen of Template 3.

From Fabric P, cut:

- Four 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles from the LIGHT side.
- Four 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles from the DARK side.

From Fabric T cut:

- Four 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles from the DARK side.
- Sixteen Template 2 from the MEDIUM (middle).
- Sixteen Template 1 from the LIGHT.

Piecing Instructions:

Block Assembly

Note: This pattern assumes a knowledge of paper piecing.

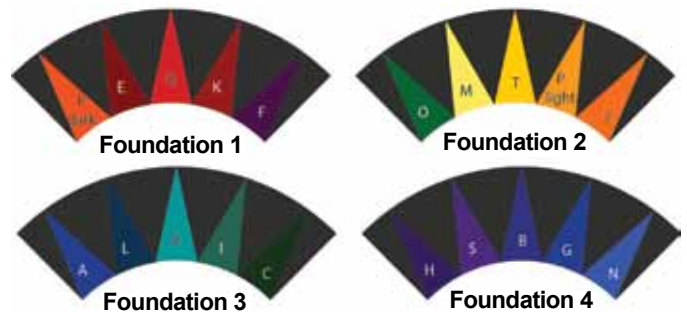


Figure 1 Make 4 of each.

- Using your preferred method of paper piecing, make four of each foundation, labeled Unit 1, 2, 3, and 4, using the fabrics listed on the template. The different font size and color will determine which fabrics to use for each unit. Refer to Figure 1 to double check. Remember that foundations are a mirror image of the finished piece. Trim around the outside solid line, and carefully remove the paper.

- Sew the Fabric T Template 1 and Template 2 pieces together, matching ends and centers, to make sixteen Center Units. Press towards Template 1 (Figure 2).



Figure 2 Make 16.

- Sew a Center Unit to the small inside curve of each foundation unit, matching ends and centers. Press towards Template 2.
- Sew a Fabric D Template 3 to the top outside curve of each foundation unit. (Figure 3) Press towards the foundation unit. Trim and square each block to 15 1/2" x 15 1/2". Label as Block 1, 2, 3, and 4 (Figure 4).

5. Sew the blocks together in rows as shown in the quilt diagram, paying close attention to orientation and placement for each block. Sew the rows together into the quilt top.

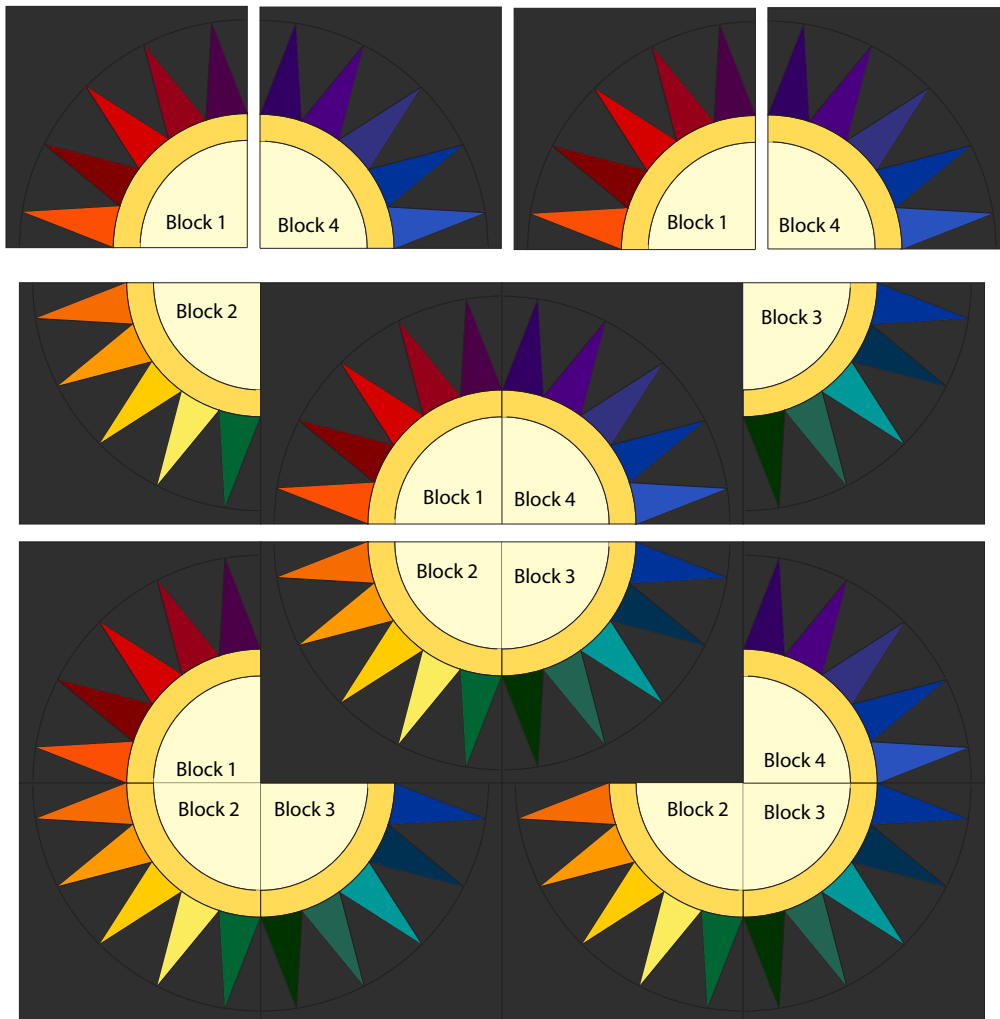
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Join 2 1/4" D strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
5. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing to measure 70" x 70" with a 1/2" seam. Press seam open.



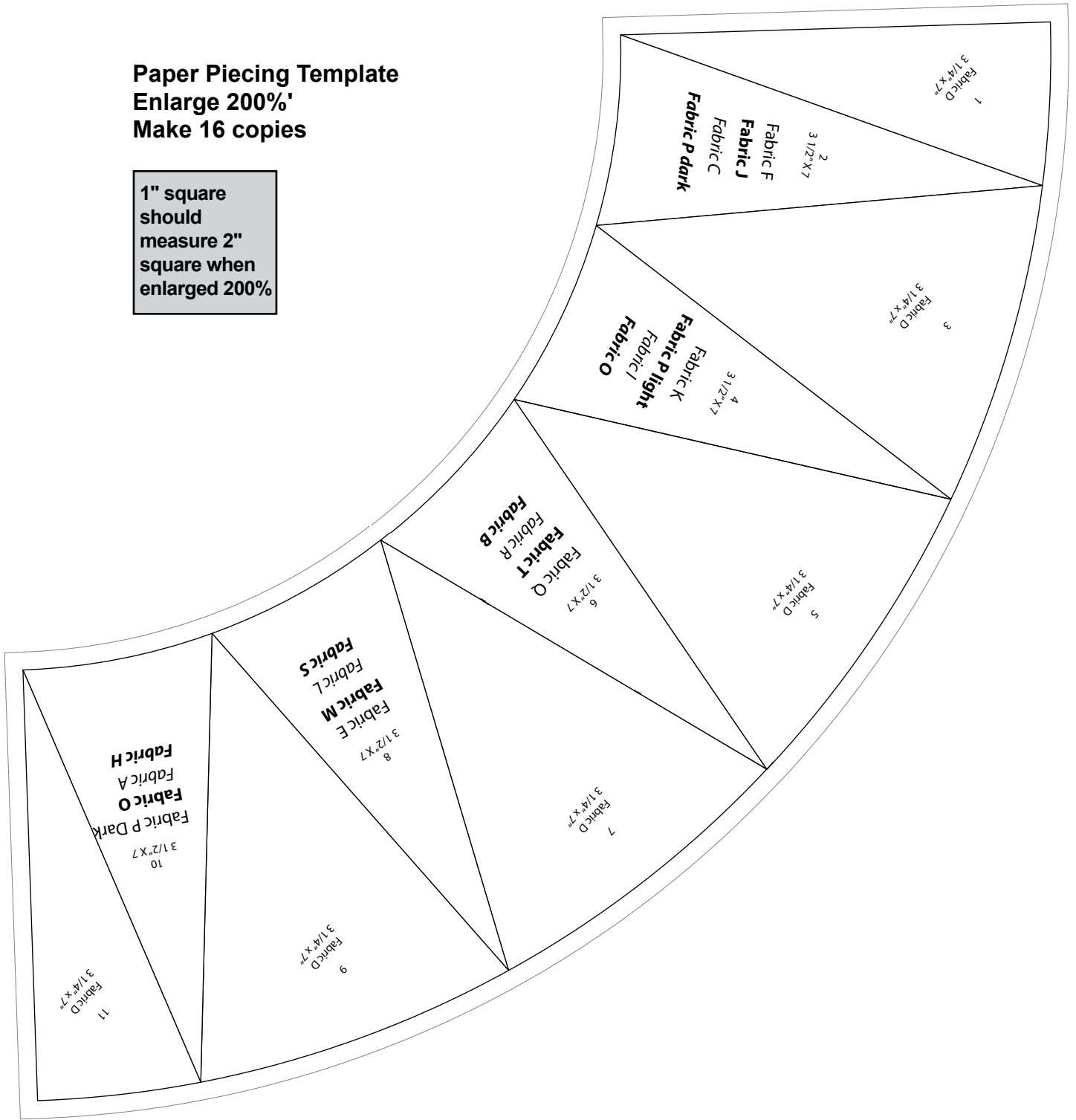

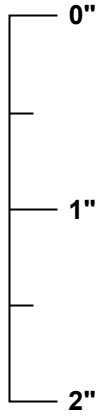


Quilt Diagram

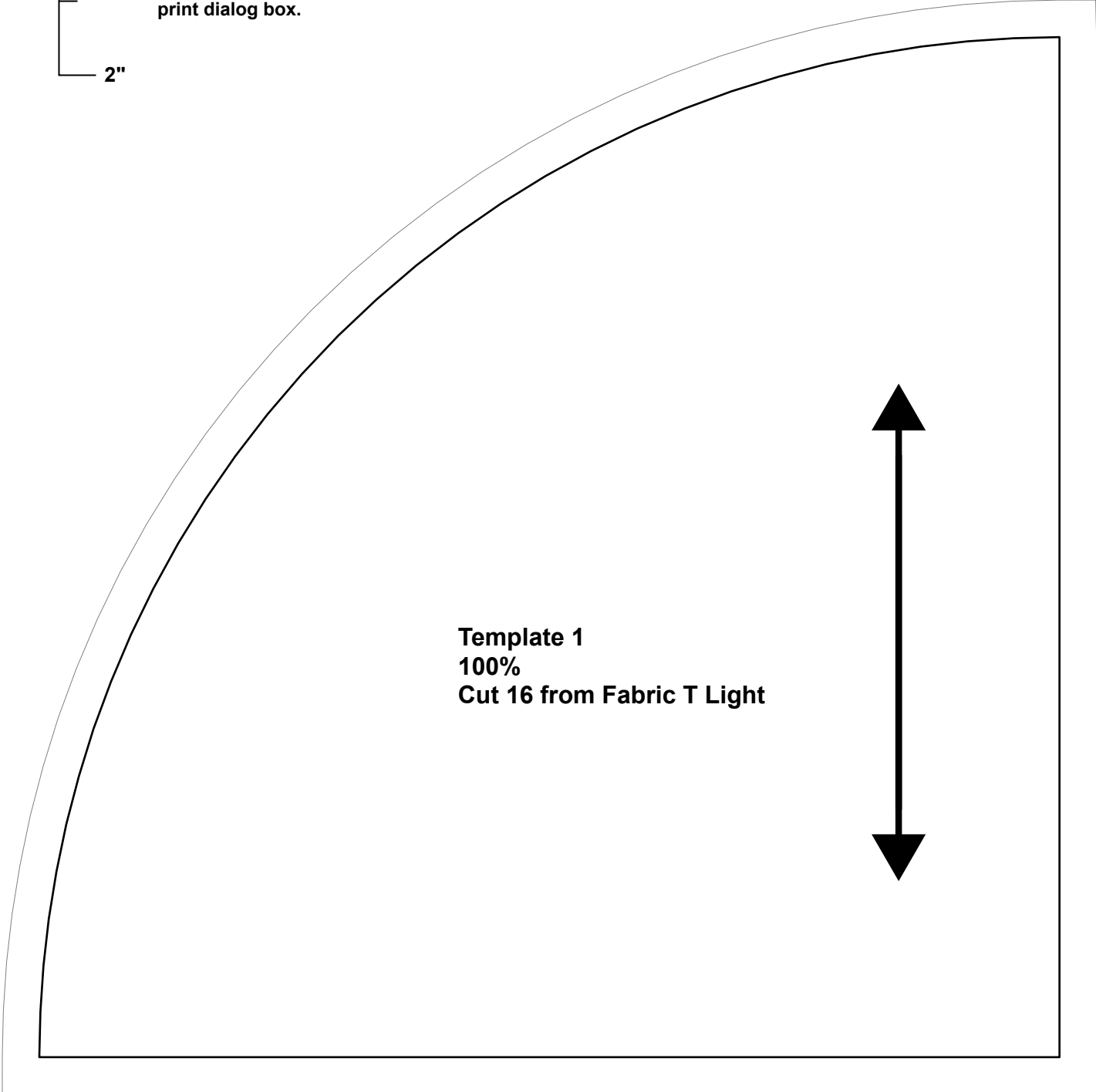

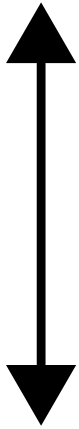
Template 2a
