## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a $1 / 4$ " seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Fussy cut twelve $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, centering image (two of each image, mirrored).

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut three 2" strips. Sub cut twelve $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and twelve 2 " squares (window frame).

## 2. Cut six 6 1/2" strips (border \#5).

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut six 2" strips. Sub cut twelve 14" strips (window frame).
2. Cut five $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips (border \#4).

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut five $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips (border \#3).

## From Fabric E :

1. Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips (border \#2).

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut five $11 / 4$ " strips. Sub cut nine 14 " sashing strips (quilt center).
2. Cut six 1 1/4" strips (long sashing and border \#1).

## From Fabric G:

1. Fussy cut four 10 " strips, lengthwise (border \#6).

## From Fabric H :

1. Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub cut forty-eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Cut one $21 / 4$ " strip. Sub cut sixteen $21 / 4$ " squares.

## From Fabric I:

1. Cut six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub cut sixty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and thirty-two $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2" rectangles.

## From Fabric J:

1. Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub cut forty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and sixteen $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2" rectangles.

## From Fabric K:

1. Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub cut sixteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and sixteen $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
2. Cut ten $21 / 4$ " strips for binding.

## Piecing Instructions:

## A. Quilt Center Window \& Border \#1

1. Sew one $61 / 2$ " B strip to bottom of A rectangle. Press toward B (Figure 1).
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 2 " $B$ square. Place on one end of one 14 " C strip, right sides together (Figure 2). Sew on marked line. Trim 1/4" away from stitch line. Press toward B. Sew BC strip to left side of A rectangle. Press toward BC (Figure 3).
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make twelve 8 " $\times 14$ " Window blocks.

Make 12.
4. Arrange blocks using quilt photo.
5. Sew one 14" F sashing strip to the right side of nine units. Press toward F (Figure 4).
6. Sew Row 1 together. Press toward F. Repeat for Rows 2 and 3 (Figure 5).
7. Sew six 1 1/4" F strips together, end to end. Press seams open.
8. Measure width of row and cut two F strips to length.

9. Sew one F strip between Rows 1 and 2. Press toward F (Figure 6).
10. Sew one F strip between Rows 2 and 3. Press toward F (Figure 6).

11. Measure sides of quilt center and cut two $F$ strips to length. Sew to opposite sides of quilt center. Press toward F (Figure 7).
12. Measure top and bottom of quilt center and cut two $F$ strips to length. Sew to the top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward F (Figure 7).

B. Border \#2 (Quilt Diagram)

1. Sew five $21 / 2$ " E strips together, end to end. Press seams open.
2. Measure sides of quilt center and cut two $E$ strips to length. Measure top and bottom of quilt center and cut two E strips to length.
3. Sew $E$ side strips to opposite sides of quilt center. Press toward E.
4. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{J}$ square to each end of top/bottom $E$ strips. Press toward J.
5. Sew one completed E strip to the top and one to the bottom. Press toward E (Quilt Diagram).

## C. Border \#3

Refer to Quilt Diagram to correctly position all end units and blocks for Borders 3-6.

1. Sew two 2 1/2" H and two 2 1/2" I squares together to make a Four-Patch block (Figure 8). Press. Make eight blocks. Set aside four blocks for Border \#4.

2. Sew five 4 1/2" D strips together, end to end. Press seams open.
3. Measure sides of quilt center and cut two $D$ strips to length. Measure top and bottom of quilt center and cut two D strips to length.
4. Sew $D$ side strips to opposite sides of quilt center. Press toward D.
5. Sew a Four-Patch block to each end of top/bottom D strips. Press toward D.
6. Sew one completed D strip to the top and one to the bottom. Press toward D (Quilt Diagram).
D. Border \#4
7. Sew one 2 1/2" J and one 2 1/2" I square together. Press. Make eight end units (Figure 9).Figure 9 End Unit Make 4.
8. Sew five 4 1/2" C strips together, end to end. Press seams open.
9. Measure sides of quilt center and subtract 4". Cut two C side strips to length. Measure top and bottom of quilt center and subtract 4 ". Cut two C top/bottom strips to length.
10. Sew an end unit to each end of $C$ side strips. Press toward C. Sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward border.
11. Sew an end unit and then a Four-Patch block from Border \#3 to each end of $C$ top/bottom strips. Press toward $C$ and then end unit. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward border.

## E. Border \#5

1. Sew three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} H$, four 2 1/2" I and two 2 1/2" J squares together to make a Nine-Patch block (Figure 10). Press. Make

2. Sew one 2 1/2" I, one 2 1/2" J and one 2 1/2" K square together. Press. Make eight end units (Figure 11).

3. Sew six 6 1/2" B strips together, end to end. Press seams open.
4. Measure sides of quilt center and subtract 4". Cut two $B$ side strips to length. Measure top and bottom of quilt center and subtract 4". Cut two B top/bottom strips to length.
5. Sew an end unit to each end of B side strips. Press toward B. Sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward border.
6. Sew an end unit and then a Nine-Patch block to each end of B top/bottom strips. Press toward B and then end unit. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward border.

## F. Border \#6

1. Sew three 2 1/2" H, four 2 1/4" H, four 2 1/2" I and two 2 1/2" J squares and four each 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" I, J and K rectangles together to make a Twenty-Five Patch block (Figure 12). Place the 2 1/4" H squares in the outer corners and the 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" rectangles in the outer edges. Press. Make four blocks.

2. Sew one 2 1/2" H, one 2 1/2" J and one 2 1/2" K square and two 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" I rectangles together. Press. Make eight end units (Figure 13).

3. Measure sides of quilt center and subtract 4". Trim two $G$ side strips to length. Measure top and bottom of quilt center and subtract 4". Trim two G top/bottom strips to length.
4. Sew an end unit to each end of G side strips. Press toward G. Sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward border.
5. Sew an end unit and then a Twenty-Five Patch block to each end of G top/bottom strips. Press toward G and then end unit. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward border.

## Finishing:

1. Cut two 104 " backing pieces. Join with a vertical $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press open. Trim to measure 94" x 104".
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with top.
5. Join ten $21 / 4 " \mathrm{~K}$ binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.
