Quilt Yardages:

Fabric A: NPEX 4759 PA	1 panel
Fabric B: NPEX 4763 DR	1/3 yard
Fabric C: NPEX 4764 K	1 yard
Fabric D: NPEX 4765 E	1/8 yard
Fabric E: NPEX 4765 G	1/4 yard
Fabric F: NPEX 4766 NE	1/8 yard
Backing: NPEX 4767 R suggested	2 1/8 yards
Batting:	35" x 73"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut large block 20 1/2" x 20 1/2" centering design.
2. Cut four small blocks 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" centering design within each one.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut four 1" strips. Use one strip to cut two 1" x 20 1/2" strips. Sew remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1" x 61 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)
2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut eight 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (Side Blocks)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 2 1/2" x 21 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 61 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)
2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut eight 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (Side Blocks)
3. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut eight 2 1/2" squares. (Side Blocks)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut twenty-four 2 1/2" squares. (Side Blocks & Outer Border Squares)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Side Blocks)

Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew two 2 1/2" D squares with two 2 1/2" E squares to make one four-patch unit. Repeat to make four units. (Figure 1)

4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.

2. Sew one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" F rectangle to right side of one Step 1 unit. Press toward F. Sew one 2 1/2" E square to the end of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" F rectangle. Sew FE strip to bottom of block. Press toward F.
3. Following order in Step 2, sew one 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" B rectangle to right side of Step 2 unit. Press toward B. Sew one 2 1/2" E square to the end of one 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" B rectangle. Sew BE strip to the bottom of the block. Press toward B.

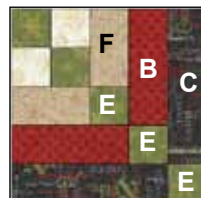


Figure 2 **Make 4.**

4. Continuing order in Steps 2 and 3, sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" C rectangle to right side of Step 3 unit. Press toward C. Sew one 2 1/2" E square to the end of one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" C rectangle. Sew CE strip to bottom of the block. Press toward C. Repeat Steps 2-4 to complete four blocks. (Figure 2)

10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.

5. Referring to diagrams for correct placement, sew two blocks from Step 4 with two 10 1/2" A squares. Press toward A squares. Repeat to make two blocks. (Figure 3)

20 1/2" x 20 1/2" unfinished.

6. Sew one block from Step 5 to both sides of 20 1/2" A square. Press toward A square.
7. Sew one 1" x 20 1/2" B strip to both ends of the runner. Press toward B. Sew one 1" x 61 1/2" B strip to the top and bottom of the runner. Press toward B.
8. Sew one 2 1/2" x 21 1/2" C strip to both ends of the runner. Press toward C. Sew one 2 1/2" E square to both ends of both 2 1/2" x 61 1/2" C strips. Press toward C. Sew one pieced border to the top and bottom of the runner. Press toward C.

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using length of fabric. Trim to 35" x 73".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join five 2 1/2" C binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.
