## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a $1 / 4$ " seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut three 22 1/2" strips; subcut three 22 1/2" squares. Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield ten quarter-square triangles. (Side Setting Triangles)
2. Use the remainder of strips to cut two $111 / 2$ " squares. Cut each square diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles. (Corner Setting Triangles)

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut nine 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)
2. Cut nine $31 / 2$ " strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 4$ " strips and two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 871 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Outer Border)
3. Cut three $151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut six 15 1/2" squares. (Alternate Blocks)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut twelve 2" strips; subcut ninety-six 2 " $\times 5$ " rectangles. (Blocks)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut eleven 2" strips; subcut forty-eight 2" $\times 3$ 1/2" rectangles and forty-eight 2 " $\times 5$ " rectangles. (Blocks)
2. Cut one 3 1/2" strip; subcut twelve 3 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

## From Fabric E :

1. Cut two 1 1/4" strips; subcut forty-eight 1 1/4" squares. (Blocks)
2. Cut eight 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to $1 / 4$ " and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 4$ " strips and two 1 1/2" x $851 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Inner Border)
3. Cut ten 2 " strips; subcut ninety-six 2 " squares and fortyeight 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut ten 2" strips; subcut one hundred-ninety-two (192) 2" squares. (Blocks)
2. Cut seven 2 3/4" strips; subcut forty-eight 2 3/4" $\times 1$ 1/4" rectangles and forty-eight 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
3. Cut eight 3 1/2" strips; subcut forty-eight 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

## Piecing Instructions:

Note: These blocks use the "sew \& flip" method of cornertriangle construction. To do this, draw a diagonal line on the back side of noted squares. With right sides together, place a marked square at the end of a second fabric piece. Sew on the line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open or toward the resulting triangle.

## Blocks

1. Using the "sew \& flip" method, sew four 2" F squares with two 2" x 5" C rectangles, one 2" x 3 1/2" D rectangle, and one 2 " x 5" D rectangle, as shown in Figure 1.


Make 1. 2" x 5" unfinished \#1


Make 1. 2" x 5" unfinished \#3


Make 1. 2" x 5" unfinished \#2


Make 1. 2" x 3 1/2" unfinished \#4
2. With right sides together, place one 2 " $\times 3$ 1/2" E rectangle perpendicular to the right end of unit \#1 from Step 1. The short side of E rectangle should be at the end of unit \#1. Sew diagonally across unit, as shown. Trim seam to 1/4"; press. (Figure 2)

Make 1. 2" x 6 1/2" unfinished.
3. Sew one $11 / 4$ " E square to the end of one $11 / 4$ " x $23 / 4$ " $F$ rectangle; press. Sew this unit to the right side of one 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" F rectangle, as shown; press. (Figure 3)

4. Sew unit \#4 from Step 1 to the bottom of the Step 3 unit; press. (Figure 4)

5. Using the "sew \& flip" method, sew one 2" E square to the end of unit \#2 from Step 1, as shown; press. (Figure 5)

6. Sew Step 5 unit to the right of unit \#3 from Step 1, as shown; press. (Figure 6)

7. Sew Step 4 unit to Step 6 unit, as shown; press. Sew Step 2 unit to the bottom; press. Repeat to make four units. (Figure 7)

8. Using the "sew \& flip" method, sew four 2" E squares with one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ D square, as shown; press. (Figure 8)

9. Sew one unit from Step 7 to both sides of one 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" F rectangle; press. Repeat. (Figure 9)

10. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2" F rectangle to both sides of the Step 8 unit; press. (Figure10)

11. Sew one Step 9 row to both sides of the Step 10 row to complete one block; press. Repeat to make twelve blocks. (Figure 11)

## Quilt Assembly: (Refer to Quilt Diagram)

1. Sew pieced blocks, alternate blocks $B$ and quarter-square and half -square setting triangles A together into diagonal rows, as shown in Quilt Diagram. Press.
2. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 851 / 2^{\prime \prime} E$ strip to both sides of the quilt; press. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 4$ " $E$ strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.
3. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 871 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strip to both sides of the quilt; press. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 4$ " $B$ strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.

## Finishing:

1. Press 108 " backing well and trim to 80 " $\times 101$ ".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join nine $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.
