## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut two 3 1/2" strips; subcut one 3 1/2" x 31 1/2" strip (Bottom Inner Border) and two 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips. (Side Inner Border)
2. Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip (Bottom Outer Border) and two 4 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips. (Side Outer Border)

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut two 4 1/2" strips; subcut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39$ 1/2" strip (Top Outer Border) and two 4 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips. (Side Outer Border)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut one 24 1/2" strip; subcut one 24 1/2" x 29 1/2" rectangle including packed floral at the bottom of the rectangle. (Center)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip; subcut two 3 1/2" squares and two 3 1/2" $\times 7$ 1/2" strips. (Side Inner Border)
2. Cut two $41 / 2$ " strips; subcut four $41 / 2$ " squares and two 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips. (Side Outer Border)
From Fabric E: (cutting reflects directional fabric)
3. Cut one 3 1/2" strip; subcut one 3 1/2" $\times 31$ 1/2" strip. (Top Inner Border)
4. Cut one 13 1/2" strip; subcut two 3 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips. (Side Inner Border)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

## From Fabric G:

1. Cut three 1" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to $1 / 4$ " and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 " $\times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two 1" x 29 1/2" strips. (Frame)

## Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew one 1" $x 29$ 1/2" G strip to both sides of the 24 1/2" x 29 1/2" C rectangle; press. Sew one 1" $\times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ G strip to the top and bottom of the rectangle; press.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of both $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ squares. Place one marked square at one end of one 3 1/2" x 13 1/2" E strip, as shown. Sew on the line and trim seam to $1 / 4$ "; press. (Figure 1)

3. Repeat Step 2, except sew square to rectangle in opposite direction. (Figure 2)

4. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strip to one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ strip; press. Sew this to the Step 2 unit, as shown, press. (Figure 3)

5. Repeat Step 4 but sew the Step 3 unit to the joined $A / D$ unit, as shown. (Figure 4)

6. Sew Step 4 pieced strip to the left side of the Quilt Center, as shown; press. Sew Step 5 pieced strip to the right side of the Quilt center, as shown; press.
7. Sew one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime} E$ strip to the top of the Quilt Center; press. Sew one 3 1/2" x 31 1/2" A strip to the bottom of the Quilt Center; press.
8. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each 4 1/2" D square. Place one marked square at one end of one 4 1/2" x 13 1/2" B strip, as shown. Sew on the line and trim seam to $1 / 4 "$; press. (Figure 5)

9. Repeat Step 8, except sew square to rectangle in opposite direction. (Figure 6)

10. Repeat Step 8 and Step 9 using 4 1/2" D squares with 4 1/2" x 18 1/2" A strips EXCEPT sew 4 1/2" squares to $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips in the directions shown. (Figure 7)

11. Sew together one Step 8 unit, one 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" D strip, and one Step 10 unit, as shown; press. (Figure 8)

12. Sew together one Step 9 unit, one 4 1/2" $\times 5$ 1/2" D strip, and one Step 10 unit, as shown; press. (Figure 9)

13. Sew Step 11 pieced strip to the left side of the Quilt Center; press. Sew Step 12 pieced strip to the right side of the Quilt Center; press.
14. Sew one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strip to the top of the Quilt Center; press. Sew one 4 1/2" x 39 1/2" A strip to the bottom of the Quilt Center; press.

## Finishing:

1. Sew two widths of backing fabric together with horizontal seam. Press seam open. Trim backing to 47" x 52".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join five 2 1/2" F binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.


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
