## Quilt Yardages:

Fabric A: SMON 5163 MU ..... 2 1/4 yards
Fabric B: SMON 5164 F ..... 1 1/3 yard
Fabric C: SMON 5164 T ..... $1 / 2$ yard
Fabric D: SMON 5164 WO ..... $1 / 2$ yard
Fabric E: SMON 5164 WG ..... $1 / 2$ yard
Fabric F: SMON 5165 FY ..... 5/8 yard
Fabric G: SMON 5167 FY ..... $1 / 2$ yard
Fabric H: SMON 5167 TG ..... $1 / 2$ yard
Fabric I: SMON 5168 WY ..... 3/4 yard
Backing: SMON 5163 MU suggested ..... $35 / 8$ yards
Batting ..... $64 " \times 64 "$
Additional supplies: Template plastic if desiredNOTE: Enlarge templates as noted. You may need to use anoutside photocopy/print shop.

## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut one Template 1.
2. Cut four Template 2.

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut seven $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut forty $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 7" strips. Subcut eight 7" x 8" rectangles.

From Fabric D:

1. Cut two 6 " strips. Subcut eight $6 " \times 6 "$ squares.

From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 6 " strips. Subcut eight 6 " $\times 6$ " squares.

## From Fabric F :

1. Cut six 2 1/2" strips for binding.

## From Fabric G:

1. Cut two 6 " strips. Subcut eight 6 " $\times 6$ " squares.

## From Fabric H :

1. Cut two 7" strips. Subcut eight 7 " $\times 8$ " rectangles.

From Fabric I:

1. Cut five $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut thirty-two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

## Piecing Instructions:

Press seams as directed by arrows or instructions.

1. Using your preferred method of paper piecing, make the Foundation 1, 2, and 3 units as shown, using the pieces listed on the foundation. (Figure 1)

2. Sew the Foundation 1 units together into a round as shown. Repeat with Foundation 2, 3, 4, and the template 2 pieces. Fold in half twice to mark the centers. (Figure 2)

3. Sew the rounds in order to the Fabric circle, matching centers. Press out towards the next round after each

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing by sewing two pieces fabric with horizontal seams. Trim to 64" x 64". Press.
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} F$ binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
