## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Background Fabric:

1. Cut seven 1" strips. Subcut twelve 1" $x 9$ 1/2" and twelve 1 " x 10 1/2" rectangles. (Block Center).

## From Fabric A:

1. Fussy cut six 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" squares, centering designs. (Block Center)

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips. Subcut (108) 2 1/2" squares. Each placemat uses eighteen squares. (Pieced Border)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips. Subcut (120) 2 1/2" squares. Each placemat uses twenty squares. (Pieced Border)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for binding.

## Placemat Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew two 1" $x 91 / 2$ " Background rectangles to the opposite sides of one $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ 1/2" panel square, followed by two 1 " x 10 1/2" Background rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of the same panel square.
2. Sew together five 2 1/2" $\times 2$ 1/2" B and five 2 1/2" $\times 2$ 1/2" C squares to make a column unit. Make two column units and sew to the left and right sides of Step 1 unit, as shown.
3. Sew together four 2 1/2" $\times 2$ 1/2" B and five 2 1/2" $\times 2$ 1/2" $C$ squares to make a row unit. Make two row units and sew to the top and bottom of Step 2 unit, as shown, to complete one placemat.
4. Repeat to make a total of six placemats.

## Finishing:

1. Cut six 17 " $\times 20$ " rectangles from backing fabric. Press.
2. Layer placemat, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with placemat top squaring corners.
5. Join two 2 1/2" D binding strips with diagonal seams for each placemat. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of placemat.
