Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

- 1. Cut three 7 1/2" strips. Subcut seventy-eight 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut three 9 1/2" strips. Subcut seventy-eight 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
- 3. Cut three 1 1/2" strips. Subcut six each 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
- 4. Cut three 2 1/2" strips. Subcut seventy-one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing Blocks)
- 5. Cut ten 2 1/4" strips (Binding)

From Fabric B:

1. Cut nine 5" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 5" x 80 1/2" and two 5" x 82 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 7 1/2" strips. Subcut seven 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut one 7 1/2" strip. Subcut one 7 1/2" square. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 7 1/2" strips. Subcut six 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut two 7 1/2" strips. Subcut seven 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric G:

1. Cut two 7 1/2" strips. Subcut seven 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric H:

1. Cut two 7 1/2" strips. Subcut seven 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric I:

- 1. Cut nine 4 1/2" strips. Subcut (142) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing Blocks)
- 2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips. Subcut thirty 2 1/2" squares. (Cornerstones)
- 3. Cut eight 4" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 4" x 71 1/2" and two 4" x 75 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)

From Fabric J:

1. Cut one 7 1/2" strip. Subcut four 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric K:

1. Cut one 7 1/2" strip. Subcut three 7 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

Piecing Instructions:

Pieced Blocks

1. Sew two 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" A rectangles to the opposite sides of one 7 1/2" Print square. (Figure 1)

2. Sew two 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" A rectangles to the top and bottom of step 1 unit to complete one pieced block. Block measures 9 1/2" square unfinished. (Figure 2)

3. Make a total number of blocks for the following Fabric Prints:

Sashing Blocks

1. Sew two 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" I rectangles to the opposite long sides of one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" A rectangle to make a sashing block. Block measures 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of seventy-one blocks. (Figure 3)


Quilt Assembly:

- 1. Refer to Quilt Diagram for block placement guide, arrange and sew together six pieced blocks to make a pieced row, alternating with five sashing blocks. Make a total of seven pieced rows.
- 2. Sew together six sashing blocks, alternating with five 2 1/2" I squares, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of six pieced sashing rows.
- 3. Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.

- 4. Inner border. Sew two 4" x 75 1/2" I strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two 4" x 71 1/2" I strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 5. Outer border. Sew two 5" x 82 1/2" B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two 5" x 80 1/2" B strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing by sewing together three widths. Press seams open. Trim backing fabric to 88" x 99". OR, press 108" fabric well and trim to size.
- 2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- Join ten 2 1/4" A binding strips with diagonal seams.
 Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of the runner.
