Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

- 1. Cut four 4 1/2" strips. Subcut thirty-two 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut two 9 1/2" strips. Subcut thirty-two 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
- 3. Cut two 13 1/2" strips. Subcut thirty-two 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
- 4. Cut five 1 1/2" strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Cornerstones)
- 5. Cut eight 1 1/2" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 1 1/2" x 71 1/2" and two 1 1/2" x 73 1/2" strips. (Inner Border #2)
- 6. Cut nine 2 1/4" strips (Binding)

From Fabric B:

- 1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Cornerstones)
- 2. Cut twenty-eight 1 1/2" strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Sashing Blocks)
- 3. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" and two 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips. (Inner Border #1)

From Fabric C:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 3. Cut eight 4 1/2" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 4 1/2" x 73 1/2" and two 4 1/2" x 81 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

From Fabric D:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric E:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric F:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric G:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric H:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric I:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric J:

- 1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
- 2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

From Fabric K:

1. Cut fourteen 1 1/2" strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Sashing Blocks)

Piecing Instructions: Pieced Blocks

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 4 1/2" A square. Place square, right sides together, on one 4 1/2" Print square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two half-square-triangle (HST) units. Open and press.
- 2. Place unit, right sides together with contrasting fabrics facing each other, on the second HST unit. The seams will face in opposite directions.

 Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two quarter-square triangle (QST) units. Open and press. Use the 45-degree line on a ruler to square up and trim to measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of four units. (Figure 1)


Figure 2 Make one.

4. Sew two step 3 units to the opposite sides of one 3 1/2" Print square to make a row unit. (Figure 2)

- 5. Sew two 3 1/2" Print squares to the opposite sides of one step 3 unit to make a row unit. Make a total of two row units. (Figure 3)
 - **Print** Figure 3 Make two.
- 6. Sew together row units to make a star unit. Then sew two 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" A rectangles to the opposite sides of star unit, followed by two 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" A rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of star unit to complete one pieced block. Block measures 13 1/2" x 13 1/2" unfinished. (Figure 4)

7. Make two blocks of <u>each</u> for the following Prints:




Cornerstones

- 1. Sew two 1 1/2" A strips to the opposite long sides of one 1 1/2" B strip. Make a total of two strip sets. Subcut fifty 1 1/2" segments (Unit A). (Figure 5)
- 2. Sew two 1 1/2" B strips to the opposite long sides of one 1 1/2" A strip. Subcut twenty-five 1 1/2" segments (Unit B). (Figure 6)
- 3. Sew together two Unit A units with one Unit B unit to make a cornerstone unit. Unit measures 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of twenty-five units. (Figure 7)



Sashing Blocks

 Sew two 1 1/2" B strips to the opposite long sides of one 1 1/2" K strip. Make a total of fourteen strip sets. Subcut forty 13 1/2" strip sets. (Figure 8)




Quilt Assembly:

- Referring to Quilt Diagram for block placement, arrange and sew together four pieced blocks, alternating with five sashing blocks, to make a pieced row. Make a total of four pieced rows.
- 2. Sew together five cornerstones, alternating with four sashing blocks, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of five pieced sashing rows.
- 3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.
- Inner border #1. Sew two 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" B strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 5. Inner border #2. Sew two 1 1/2" x 71 1/2" A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two 1 1/2" x 73 1/2" A strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- Outer border. Sew two 4 1/2" x 73 1/2" C strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two 4 1/2" x 81 1/2" C strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing by sewing together three widths. Press seams open. Trim backing fabric to 89" x 89'. OR press 108" fabric well and trim to size.
- 2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- Join nine 2 1/4" A binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.






