## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut thirty-two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut two $91 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut thirty-two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
3. Cut two $131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut thirty-two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
4. Cut five $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Cornerstones)
5. Cut eight $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece strips and subcut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 711 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 731 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Inner Border \#2)
6. Cut nine 2 1/4" strips (Binding)

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Cornerstones)
2. Cut twenty-eight $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Sashing Blocks)
3. Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece strips and subcut two 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" and two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71$ 1/2" strips. (Inner Border \#1)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut one $31 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
3. Cut eight $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece strips and subcut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 73$ 1/2" and two 4 1/2" x 81 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric E:
3. Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
4. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut one 3 1/2" strip. Subcut ten 3 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric $\mathbf{G}$ :

1. Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric H :
3. Cut one $31 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
4. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric I:

1. Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
From Fabric J:
3. Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced Blocks)
4. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Subcut four 4 1/2" squares. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric K:

1. Cut fourteen 1 1/2" strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (Sashing Blocks)

## Piecing Instructions: <br> \section*{Pieced Blocks}

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A}$ square. Place square, right sides together, on one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Print square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two half-square-triangle (HST) units. Open and press.
2. Place unit, right sides together with contrasting fabrics facing each other, on the second HST unit. The seams will face in opposite directions.
3. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two quarter-square triangle (QST) units. Open and press. Use the 45 -degree line on a ruler to square up and trim to measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Make a total of four units. (Figure 1)

4. Sew two step 3 units to the opposite sides of one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Print square to make a row unit. (Figure 2)

5. Sew two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Print squares to the opposite sides of one step 3 unit to make a row unit. Make a total of two row units. (Figure 3)

6. Sew together row units to make a star unit. Then sew two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A rectangles to the opposite sides of star unit, followed by two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of star unit to complete one pieced block. Block measures $131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. (Figure 4)

## Cornerstones

1. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} A$ strips to the opposite long sides of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ B strip. Make a total of two strip sets. Subcut fifty $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments (Unit A). (Figure 5)
2. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to the opposite long sides of one $11 / 2$ " A strip. Subcut twenty-five $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments (Unit B). (Figure 6)
3. Sew together two Unit A units with one Unit B unit to make a cornerstone unit. Unit measures $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Make a total of twenty-five units. (Figure 7)


## Sashing Blocks

1. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to the opposite long sides of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{K}$ strip. Make a total of fourteen strip sets. Subcut forty 13 1/2" strip sets. (Figure 8)

Quilt Assembly:

1. Referring to Quilt Diagram for block placement, arrange and sew together four pieced blocks, alternating with five sashing blocks, to make a pieced row. Make a total of four pieced rows.
2. Sew together five cornerstones, alternating with four sashing blocks, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of five pieced sashing rows.
3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.
4. Inner border \#1. Sew two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 67$ 1/2" B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 711 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
5. Inner border \#2. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 711 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 731 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
6. Outer border. Sew two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 731 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{C}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 811 / 2^{\prime \prime} C$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing by sewing together three widths. Press seams open. Trim backing fabric to 89" x 89'. OR press 108" fabric well and trim to size.
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join nine $21 / 4$ " A binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
