Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Fussy cut four 14 3/4" x 19" rectangles, centered on the panels.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut one 14 3/4" strip; sub-cut two 14 3/4" x 19" rectangles. (Backing)


From Fabric C:

1. Cut one 14 3/4" strip; sub-cut two 14 3/4" x 19" rectangles. (Backing)

Piecing Instructions:

The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Place one 14 3/4" x 19" yellow bordered A panel, right sides together with one 14 3/4" x 19" B piece. Sew the two pieces together leaving an opening at the bottom for turning to make one Unit 1 piece. Repeat to make a second Unit 1 piece. (Figure 1)






2. Place one 14 3/4" x 19" Blue bordered A panel, right sides together with one 14 3/4" x 19" C piece. Sew the two pieces together leaving an opening at the bottom for turning to make one Unit 2 piece. Repeat to make a second Unit 2 piece. (Figure 2)





3. Turn the two Unit 1 and two Unit 2 pieces right side out. Stuff each with poly fill and sew the opening closed to make four pillows total. (Figure 3 & 4)
