




Fabric B:	SSPR 5329 Y	1/4 yard
Fabric C:	SSPR 5329 P	1/4 yard
Fabric D:	SSPR 5329 B	3/4 yard
Fabric E:	SSPR 5329 G	1/8 yard
Fabric F:	SSPR 5327 DB	1/4 yard
Fabric G:	SSPR 5330 MU	1/4 yard
Fabric H:	SSPR 5328 B	1/4 yard
Backing:	SSPR 5326 B Suggested	1 yard
Batting	four 16" x 19'	

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut nine 1 1/2" strips. (Blocks)

From Fabric B:

1. Cut three 1 1/2" strips. (Blocks)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 1 1/2" strips. (Blocks)

From Fabric D:

- 1. Cut three 1 1/2" strips. (Blocks)
- 2. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut one 1 1/2" strip. (Blocks)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut one 5" strip; sub-cut five 5" x 15 1/2" strips. (Center Block)

From Fabric G:

1. Cut four 1 1/4" strips; sub-cut eight 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" squares. (Center Block Border)

From Fabric H:


1. Cut one 5" strip; sub-cut five 5" x 15 1/2" strips. (Center Block)

Piecing Instructions:


The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew together one 1 1/2" B strip, one 1 1/2" A strip and one 1 1/2" D strip lengthwise to make one Strip Set 1. Repeat to make three Strip Set 1's total. (Figure 1)


2. Cut the Strip Set 1 into sixty-four 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 3 strips. (Figure 2)



- 3. Sew one 1 1/2" A strip to each side of one 1 1/2" C strip lengthwise to make one Strip Set 2. Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2. (Figure 3)
- 4. Cut the Strip Set 2 into thirty-two 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 4 strips. (Figure 4)



- 5. Sew one 1 1/2" A strip to each side of one 1 1/2" E strip lengthwise to make one Strip Set 3. (Figure 5)
- 6. Cut the Strip Set 3 into twenty-four 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 5 strips. (Figure 6)






Figure 7 Make 32 blocks

 Sew one Unit 3 strip to the top and to the bottom of one Unit 4 strip lengthwise to make one 3 1/2" Block Two square. Repeat to make thirty-two Block Two squares total. (Figure 7)

Placemat Assembly:

- 1. Sew one 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" G strip to the top and to the bottom of one 5" x 15 1/2" F strip lengthwise to make one Placemat #1 Center Block. (Figure 8)
- 2. Sew together four Block Two squares and three Unit 5 strips alternating them from left to right. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of one Placemat #1 Center Block to make one Placemat #1 top. (Figure 8)
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a second Placemat #1 top.



- 4. Sew one 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" G strip to the top and to the bottom of one 5" x 15 1/2" H strip lengthwise to make one Placemat #2 Center Block. (Figure 9)
- 5. Sew together four Block Two squares and three Unit 5 strips alternating them from left to right. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of one Placemat #2 Center Block to make one Placemat #2 top. (Figure 9)
- 6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make a second Placemat #2 top.



Finishing:

- 1. Cut four $16^{"x} x 19"$ rectangles from backing fabric. Press well.
- 2. Layer placemat, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with placemat top, squaring corners.
- Join seven 2 1/2" D binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of one placemat.




