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## **Cutting Instructions:**

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric unless otherwise stated.

All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated.

Fabric A: HOLL 601 MU

1. Cut (2) 4 1/2" strips. Sub cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric B: HOLL 601 RB 1. Cut (4) 2" strips.

2. Cut (5) 2 1/4" strips for binding.

**Fabric C**: HOLL 602 LB 1. Cut (1) 2 1/2" strip.

**Fabric D:** HOLL 602 R 1. Cut (1) 2 1/2" strip.

Fabric E: HOLL 602 Y

1. Cut (2) 4 1/2" strips. Sub cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric F: HOLL 603 G

1. Cut (1) 2" strip. Sub cut (4) 2" squares.

**Fabric G:** HOLL 603 MU 1. Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips.

**Fabric H:** HOLL 603 R 1. Cut (1) 2 1/2" strip.

**Fabric I:** HOLL 604 B 1. Cut (1) 2 1/2" strip.

**Fabric J:** HOLL 604 MU 1. Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips.

**Fabric K:** HOLL 604 Y 1. Cut (4) 3 1/2" strips.

Fabric L: HOLL 605 DB

Cut (1) 3 1/2" strip. Sub cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.
 Cut (1) 4 1/2" strip. Sub cut (8) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric M: HOLL 605 R


1. Cut (1) 4 1/2" strip. Sub cut (8) 4 1/2" squares.



## **Piecing Instructions:**

#### 4-Patch Blocks

1. Sew (1) J 2 1/2" strip and (1) C 2 1/2" strip together. Press seam to one side. Cross cut (8) 2 1/2" segments (Figure 1).



- 2. Repeat Step 1 for each of the following combinations: I/G, J/H, and D/G.
- 3. Combine two segments as shown in Figure 2. Sew together to complete one 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" 4-patch block. Press. Repeat to make 8 blocks for each combination.




- 4. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, layout 4-Patch blocks and 4 1/2" squares. Sew each row together. Press seams in alternate directions from row to row.
- 5. Sew rows together. Press.

- 6. Measure side of quilt center and cut four B1 strips to match.
- 7. Sew trimmed B1 strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press toward B1.
- 8. Sew one 2" F square to each end of the remaining B1 strips. Press toward B1.
- 9. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward B1.
- 10. Repeat steps 6-9, using K 3 1/2" strips and L 3 1/2" squares.

## Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing with a vertical seam to measure 49" x 49".
- 2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with top.
- 5. Join (5) 2 1/4" B2 binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to back of the guilt.
