Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric unless otherwise stated. LOF - parallel to selvedges. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated.

Fabric A: WELC 3011 LM

1. Cut (3) 6 1/2" squares for block background.

Fabric B: WELC 3015 LM

- 1. Cut (1) 2" strip. Subcut (3) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- 2. Cut (1) 2" strip for horizontal sashing strip.
- 3. Cut (1) 5 1/2" strip. Subcut (3) 5 1/2" squares for letters and (4) 3 1/2" squares for corners.
- 4. Cut (4) 2 1/4" strips for binding.

Fabric C: WELC 3011 P

1. Cut (2) 6 1/2" squares for block background.

Fabric D: WELC 3015 J

- 1. Cut (1) 2" strip. Subcut (2) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- 2. Cut (1) 5 1/2" strip. Subcut (2) 5 1/2" squares for letters.
- 3. Cut (2) 2" strips for horizontal sashing strip.

Fabric E: WELC 3011 B

1. Cut (3) 6 1/2" squares for block background.

Fabric F: WELC 3015 Y

- 1. Cut (1) 2" strips. Subcut (3) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- 2. Cut (1) 5 1/2" strip. Subcut (3) 5 1/2" squares for letters.

Fabric G: WELC 3010 Y

1. Cut (1) 2 3/4" strip. Subcut (2) 2 3/4" x 8" strips for vertical sashing.

Fabric H: WELC 3010 LM

1. Cut (1) 2 3/4" strip. Subcut (2) 2 3/4" x 8" strips for vertical sashing.

Fabric I: WELC 3010 BB

1. Cut (1) 2 3/4" strip. Subcut (2) 2 3/4" x 8" strips for vertical sashing.

Fabric J: WELC 3014 BB

1. Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip for horizontal band.

Fabric K: WELC 3009 MU

1. Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip for horizontal band.

Fabric L: WELC 3013 BB

1. Cut (4) 3 1/2" strips for border.

Piecing Instructions:

- 1. Cut eight 5 1/2" squares of fusible webbing and transfer to wrong side of 5 1/2" B, D and F squares. Trace letter templates to freezer paper and cut out. Iron templates to RIGHT side of fabric squares and cut out letters.
- 2. Pair the letters with the coordinating 6-1/2" background squares as shown on quilt diagram and Figure 1. Remove fusible backing from letters and center on squares. Fuse in place.

- 3. Stitch the letters to the block backgrounds using your preferred stitch. **Note:** I like to use a simple machine zigzag stitch and always audition my threads and stitches on scrap fabric.
- 4. Sew a coordinating 2" x 6-1/2" strip to each letter block, referring to the quilt diagram and Figure 2.



Some strips are stitched on the top, some on the bottom. Press seams toward the strips.

5. Refer to the quilt diagram and Figure 3, join the letters and 2 3/4" x 8" vertical sashing strips to make the two rows. Press seams toward the vertical strips.

- 6. Measure quilt from side to side. It should measure 31 1/4" wide BUT use your own measurement for the next step.
- 7. Trim both K and J 6 1/2" strips and B and D horizontal 2" strips to the measurement

- you got in Step 6 above. Sew the Letter rows, 2" horizontal strips and 6 1/2" strips to complete the quilt center. Press seams well.
- Measure quilt from side to side and trim two
 1/2" L border strips to this length; sew to quilt top and bottom. Press toward border.
- 9. Trim remaining 3 1/2" L border strips to fit sides (allowing for ½" seams) and sew one 3 1/2" B square to each short end. Sew these to quilt sides to complete quilt center. Press toward border.


Finishing:


- 1. Press fabric well. Prepare backing to measure 45" x 46".
- 2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with top.
- 5. Join (4) 2 1/4" B binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.


