# Worker Bee Basket

The worker bee is the powerhouse of the hive and has a long list of responsibilities in her 6 weeks of life, when she will die from exhaustion and broken wings. Her duties depend specifically upon her age and include: cleaning cells, feeding larvae and attending to the Queen bee, foraging and guarding the hive, storing food, regulating the temperature of the hive to a constant 36–37 °C during winter and summer, making honey, making bee bread, producing beeswax to build the comb, and setting the propolis—just to name a few!

Honeybees are social insects and live in a cooperative society. A colony consists of one breeding female called the Queen Bee, a few hundred males called Drone Bees and a large population of sterile females called Worker Bees.

"Bees fly at 24km/hr and within an 8km radius of their hive. A foraging bee weighs approximately 100mg and carries, while in flight, a load of around 70mg divided between 40mg of nectar and 30mg of pollen. One-twelfth of a teaspoon is the amount of honeybee makes in her lifetime."

The Queen Bee is the mother of all the bees. She's easily recognizable as she has a long body to house all her eggs and has short wings because she only really flies once in her lifetime as a virgin bee where she will mate with multiple males in her single nuptial flight. She keeps all the sperm she has onboard and uses it her entire life (about 5 years) to repopulate the colony. She communicates using her pheromones which are transmitted throughout the whole colony by physical contact between the bees, and which inhibit the other bee's fertility. She's completely waited upon—is fed and cleaned. Her duties include hive morale and egg laying. She lays up to 2000 eggs a day in the summer—which is equivalent to her full body weight. She is able to control the sex of the eggs she lays.

#### **Care Instructions**

Wash in cold water using mild soap if needed. Pat or hang to dry and store for later use. Do not use with heat or raw meats.
