

Frequently Asked Questions

What is EAR ITCH MD used for?

EAR ITCH MD works to revitalize, moisturize, and protect dry and irritated skin in the external ear canal.

How do I use EAR ITCH MD?

First, prime the bottle by spraying it in the sink until it sprays normally (should take 1-2 sprays). Then apply 1-2 sprays in the outer ear canal as needed. Always consult a doctor before use.

Is EAR ITCH MD safe for use?

EAR ITCH MD is made of essential and naturally occurring oils. It is safe for use.

How often should I use EAR ITCH MD?

It is recommended to use EAR ITCH MD as needed.

Is EAR ITCH MD safe for kids?

Yes, when used as directed, this product is safe for children 2 years of age and up. As with any product for children under 12 years of age, you should consult a doctor before use. Do not use this product if you are allergic to any of its ingredients.

How does EAR ITCH MD work?

EAR ITCH MD is a topical spray that targets the dry, irritated skin of the ear canal to help revitalize itchy ears.

How should EAR ITCH MD be used?

EAR ITCH MD is for external use only. Spray 1-2 sprays in the outer ear canal as needed. For earbuds, spray on a clean fingertip and lightly rub around the area that will come in contact with the earbud to help lubricate and protect the ear canal. For hearing aid use, use after removing hearing aid devices to help lubricate and protect the outer ear canal.

Who should use EAR ITCH MD?

-Adults and children 2 years and up can use this product for the temporary relief of itching associated with minor skin irritation in the external ear canal. For children 12 and younger, contact your doctor before use.

What are the ingredients in EAR ITCH MD?

Coconut oil, light mineral oil, jojoba oil, apricot kernel oil, laurel berry fruit oil, tea tree oil, vitamin E, liquid germall plus.

How long should I use EAR ITCH MD?

Use as needed, but if conditions worsen, or if symptoms persist for more than 7 days or clear up and occur again within a few days, discontinue use and consult a doctor.

Is EAR ITCH MD an over-the-counter product?

Yes, EAR ITCH MD can be purchased over the counter.

Is EAR ITCH MD safe to use in children with ear tubes?

This product is not recommended for use in children with ear tubes or individuals with a perforated eardrum. Always consult a doctor before use.

What is the active ingredient in EAR ITCH MD?

There are no active ingredients in this product. The natural and essential oils all work together to provide the soothing effects of EAR ITCH MD.

How many sprays of EAR ITCH MD should I use?

It is suggested to spray one to two times in or around the outer ear canal as needed.

What happens if I get EAR ITCH MD in my eyes?

Rinse eyes thoroughly for 15 minutes or call a doctor.
