CARE INSTRUCTIONS

With a little care you can prolong the life of your mirror. The following information is only intended as a general guideline. Please follow the instructions to ensure maximum longevity of your SARAH ELLISON. mirror. Timber is responsive to its environment, be mindful that heat and moisture can cause movement and cracks in joints and damage lacquer.

- Avoid exposing wood to direct heat and sunlight
- Maintain consistent humidity in the space to prevent excessive ٠ expansion and contraction of wooden pieces and joints
- Over time, air and sunlight will change the colour of natural wood. ٠ Occasionally rotate the items placed on your wood furniture to allow a more uniform colour to develop.
- Avoid using abrasives, and harsh chemicals cleaners .
- Do not place hot items such as hair straighteners directly onto the timber surface. Ensure tivets or surface protectors such as placement are used.
- Keep rough and sharp objects away from wood surfaces.
- Apply protective pads to the undersides of items being displayed on.





STEP 1


Open the box carefully, ensuring the blade of the knife does not come into contact with the product. Remove packaging and lift the product out of the box and gently place face down onto a clean, flat, surface on the ground. We recommend using a towel or sheet underneath for protection.



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STEP 3

Use provided plugs or stickers to cover the bolt holes. Periodic tightening of the screws may be required if mirror becomes loose from moving the mirror.



STEP 2

Place the plinth base upright and carefully slide the mirror into the slot. Ensure the long straight edge of the mirror is place against the inside edge of the slot. Once this is in place, whilst holding the glass in place, insert the bolts and washers as shown into the holes on the outside of the plinth. Slowly fasten the bolts using the allen key provided into the holes, securing the mirror in place.
