




STEP 1

STEP 2


Remove packaging and lift the product up out of box and gently place on ground.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

With a little care you can prolong the life of your furniture. The following information is only intended as a general guideline. Please follow the instructions to ensure maximum longevity of your Sarah Ellison furniture.

It is important to be mindful in the placement of your piece, as extreme conditions (such as harsh sunlight) can change the colour of the finish. Timber is responsive to its environment, be mindful that heat and moisture can cause movement and cracks in joints and damage lacquer.

Our stone is treated with a protective coating however all spills should be cleaned quickly to avoid stains. Wipe spills immediately with a damp, clean cloth to avoid staining, as stone is naturally porous, the longer the spill remains, the harder it is to remove. We recommend that you use mats and coasters to protect your marble and stone from heat, scratches and permanent marks. Stone is a natural product of the earth and must be cleaned with gentle cleaners. Do not use scouring cream or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface. Never use acidic or abrasive cleaners or vinegar on either stone or marble surfaces.
