




### STEP 1

### STEP 2


Remove packaging and lift the product up out of box and gently place on ground.

### CARE INSTRUCTIONS

With a little care you can prolong the life of your furniture. The following information is only intended as a general guideline. Please follow the instructions to ensure maximum longevity of your Sarah Ellison furniture. It is important to be mindful in the placement of your piece, as extreme conditions (such as harsh sunlight) can change the colour of the finish. Timber is responsive to its environment, be mindful that heat and moisture can cause movement and cracks in joints and damage lacquer. As this is a high gloss finish, some light scratching is to be expected, to minimise any marks we recommend high quality soft cloths and to avoid circular motions. Where possible apply protective pads to the undersides of items being displayed on painted surfaces. We also recommend using placemats and trivets to avoid spills soaking into the timber, and to also protect against heat transfer. The general rule is if something is too hot to hold, it is too hot to place on timber. Should spills occur, wipe immediately with a damp cloth. Periodically also check and re-tighten any fasteners, we recommend every six months.
