# **Product: SAW**

Description: ACID DESCALER for REMOVING SCALE and RUST from EQUIPMENT.

# **FEATURES**

- SAW is a clear pale yellow liquid. It is a strong acid for removing scale and rust off equipment.
- SAW is a concentrated product so a little goes a long way. It is based on phosphoric acid, a strong acid that doesn't have unpleasant fumes like hydrochloric or nitric acid.
- SAW contains a low foaming detergent to aid in penetration of soils for more effective descaling

### **HOW & WHERE TO USE**

- SAW is normally used at dilutions from 1:10 to 1:100 dependent on the amount of scale or rust to be removed.
- It can be used to descale commercial dishwashers. Add from 500 ml to 1 litre to wash tank and run for a few cycles. Then empty, rinse out and refill.
- To descale urns, bain-maries, kettles, etc. use at concentrations from 1:10 to 1:100 and allow to soak for a few hours.
- If descaling aluminium equipment use dilute solutions and do not soak for long periods. Rinse with plenty of water afterwards.
- SAW can also remove barnacles and scale off boats, and cement off brick work.
   Use at 1:5 and scrub carefully over surface. Wear chemical resistant goggles and protective clothing.
- It can also remove heavy rust deposits from old tools. Simply soak in a solution until rust is removed.
- SAW can cause burns. Avoid all contact with skin and eyes, and wear suitable chemical resistant clothing.
