
## Making Life Easier And Safer

Each pair of Cobra FS300 family safety radio set has been paired at the factory. They are ready to use without setup.

(If interference occurs, or if you need to re-pair a radio set, see the section on **New Pairing**.)



# **Using Your Radio**

## Call Button

Press one time to alert others that you are calling. This will send a ringtone to the other person. (Not valid for child unit)

### Menu/Power Button

Press and hold **Menu** button for 4 seconds to turn the radio on or off.

Press and hold the Talk button to communicate with others. The microphone should be about 2 inches from your mouth When talking, speak in normal voice,

Release the Talk button when you are finished talking and listen for a response from the other person. You cannot receive at the same time while pressing the Talk button.

**NOTE:** Both radios must be on the same channel to

### Volume/Channel (+) and (-) Buttons

Press the + or - button to increase or decrease the volume There are 8 different volume levels with 8 being the highest volume.

# **Child Communication Mode**

'C' displayed while parent unit is ready to talk to child unit.



## **Enter Child Communication Mode**

Press the Menu button 3 times until 'C' and flashing '-' displayed simultaneously, then press + button until 'y' appears and finally press **Menu** button to enter to Child Communication Mode)



#### **Exit Child Communication Mode**

displayed. Then press the "+" button until "y" is displayed. Press the **Menu** button to exit the Child Communication Mode.

# **Normal Two-way** Radio Mode

After exiting Child Communication Mode and returned to normal Two-way Radio Mode.

### **Channel Change**

To change the channel press the **Menu** button once (do not hold). Once the channel is flashing, press the + or - buttons to select your channel.

### **Channel Scan**

To scan your channels to either monitor or find someone in your group with a different channel, press the Menu button twice until the **Scan** icon appears with a - flashing on the display. Press the + button until the Y appears and then press the Talk button to start scanning. To turn scanning off, press the Menu button twice and a Y should appear flashing on the screen below the scan icon. Press the - button to turn off scan mode. Press the Talk

#### **Power Button**

Press and hold **Power** button for 4 seconds to turn the radio on or off. Talk button backlight flashes every 2 seconds while child unit is ready to listen.

#### **Battery Low Indicator**

During normal operation, the child unit will send a signal to the parent unit every 10 minutes when the battery reaches a low power level condition. A warning tone will sound on the parent unit.

#### **Talk Button**

Press and hold Talk button to communication with others Release the Talk button when talking finished.

#### **VOX Mode**


- · When an incoming transmission is received, the child unit will automatically switch to **VOX** mode for 2
- When in **VOX** mode, hands free communication is enabled and the radio will automatically transmit to the parent unit when audio is detected at the microphone. The Talk button backlight is **On** to indicate it is transmitting.
- Adjust the lanyard so that the microphone is approximately 1 foot from your child's mouth.
- Speaker volume is pre-set to optimum level and is not user adjustable.

### Micro-USB Charge Jack

Plug the USB cable into USB-compatible power port, then, insert the Micro-USB's connector directly into the charging port located right side of the child unit.

· During charging, Talk button backlit flashes faster (around 3 times per second).

t will take 5 hours for a full charge.

## **New Pairing**

1. With the child unit turned off, simultaneously press and hold the Talk button and the Power button for 5 seconds until an audible tone is heard. The audible tone will repeat every 2 seconds and the Talk button backlight will flash to indicate the child unit is awaiting pairing from the parent unit.
