

FLOODIE SAVES THE DAY: MANHATTAN CONDO AVOIDS \$200,000 IN DAMAGE

COMPANY

A 32-story, 55-unit luxury condominium building located in Manhattan installed Floodie flood sensors to mitigate the risk of water damage.

RESULT

At 10:00 AM on December 12, 2018, Floodie sent an SMS alert stating there was a flood on the 10th floor in an ensuite bathroom.

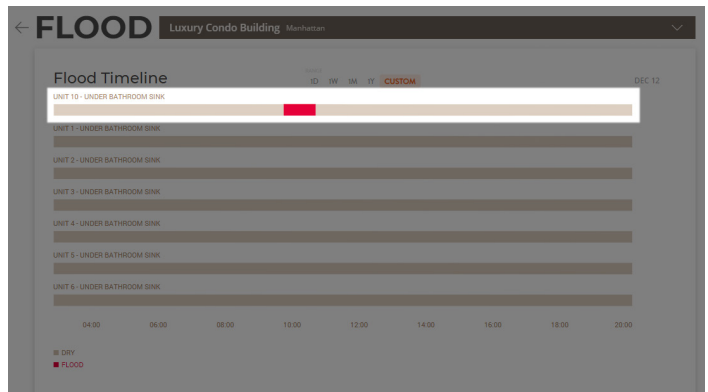
The facility manager on duty quickly responded and fixed the cause: a burst pipe under the sink. The condo avoided approximately \$200,000 in damage.

“The flood would have been disastrous because two apartments and a common area are directly below the unit with the burst pipe. We estimate about \$200k in damage was avoided.”
