Operating Instructions

WARNING: Please make sure to take note of the Important Safety Instructions before using Tick Tock Turtle. If these safety instructions are not taken into consideration, fire, electric shock, other injury or damage to the product or other property may occur.

WARNING: Please read all safety instructions for any accessories or other products before using with Tick Tock Turtle. emagine A is not responsible for the operation of third-party accessories or their compliance with safety and regulatory standards.

For indoor, dry-location use only. Do not get unit wet or submerge in water. In the event that the unit gets in contact with the water, unplug all cables and turn it OFF. Allow to dry thoroughly before reusing. Do not re-connect to the power outlet if wet or damaged.

Handle with care. Do not drop or disassemble to avoid injury, damage to this product or other property.

Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures.

To be used in environments where temperatures are between 5°C (40°F) and 38°C (100°F). Exposure to extreme temperatures can result in reduced battery life or cause the product to briefly stop working.

Charge before use. Tick Tock Turtle comes with a rechargeable lithium-polymer battery that must be charged for 5 hours using the included AC power adapter before use.

Cleaning. Disconnect all cables before cleaning. Clean the product with a slightly moist cloth. Do not use cleaning agents such as soap, detergent or other chemicals. Never run water over unit. Allow to dry completely before re-using.

Important Safety Instructions

WARNING: The AC Adapter or USB cords are a potential strangulation hazard. Keep away from children under 3 years.

CAUTION: Ensure that Tick Tock Turtle is in condition for safe use by routine inspection. If there are any damaged or broken parts, immediately remove the product from use.

CAUTION: DO NOT GET WET. Do not use Tick Tock Turtle and its accessories in the rain, near sinks or in other wet locations. Ensure food or liquid is not spilled on the product or its accessories.

CAUTION: Keep away from fire or other dangers.

CAUTION: DO NOT REPAIR OR MODIFY. Tick Tock Turtle does not include any user-serviceable parts. Stop using the product immediately if the product has come in contact with any liquids, been damaged or suffered a severe fall or impact.

CAUTION: Keep the device at least 6" (15cm) away from pacemakers and other similar medical devices that may be sensitive to devices that contain magnets and emit electromagnetic fields

Battery and A/C Adapter

WARNING: The lithium rechargeable battery cannot be removed from the product. For your safety, never try to remove the battery. For power or battery issues, please contact emagine A customer care.

CAUTION: Charge the battery only under an adult's supervision.

CAUTION: When charging the unit use only the provided AC adapter.

WARNING: Not for use by children under 3. Misuse of AC adapter can cause electric shock.

- AC adapter should be connected to a power outlet only by an adult.
- Precautions should be observed during handling and use to prevent electrical shock.
- The AC adapter may become warm during normal use. Allow adequate ventilation and use care when handling the AC adapter.
- Do not charge Tick Tock Turtle when it is on the bed with a child.
- Ensure hands are dry when connecting or disconnecting.
- The AC adapter should be examined for conditions such as damage to the cord, plug, housing or other parts that may result in the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury to persons. If any such conditions are present, the AC adapter should not be used.
