Satin Ponytails



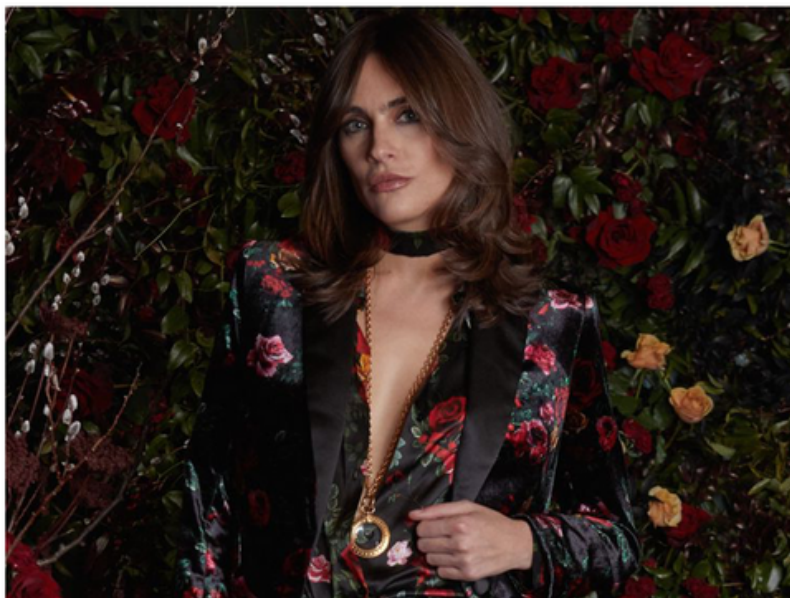
