Our SS20 collection, Mudlarker, imagines some of the detritus lost in time, a Tudor lovers token, a Georgian barge lock: treasures unearthed whilst sifting the rocks, oyster shells, broken glass and mud of the river bed.

The collection uses Elizabethan goldsmithing techniques and man-made gemstones empathic to this period. The finish has been aged, suggesting years at the bottom of the river. The collection ranges in price from £85 - £1,250.

The Thames has been a willing recipient of broken hearts, lost treasure, discarded dreams and detritus for two millennia. During low tide, its murky waters deposit long-lost fragments of the city on the foreshore.



Lylie's Sustainable Jewellery finds wealth in waste by salvaging precious metals from discarded electronics. 'Salvaged Gold' and 'Salvaged Silver' are used along with recycled antique diamonds and man-made gemstones.
