Lylie's sets out to create jewellery that is exciting and different, by salvaging precious metals from electronic waste and making fine jewellery from it. Impeccably crafted in the UK and inherently eco, Lylie's is recognized with a unique Recycled Hallmark from the Assay Office for the Salvaged Gold and Salvaged Silver used.

We have gone to considerable efforts to ensure our jewellery is ecologically sound, from working with a refiner who recycles electronic scrap, to sourcing workshops across England to secure the finest artisan trades needed to hand-make the designs. Whenever it has not been possible to use 100% recycled metals, or where we produce emissions in manufacture, that is stated clearly to make our customers aware. With time we hope to further reduce our environmental footprint.

Launching with 2 collections. The first is Imperfect Treasures. Every piece has its own history. Each tiny treasure has been collected using metal detectors at excavation sites around England, where they have lain hidden for perhaps hundreds of years. They are what we call perfectly imperfect. The second is Corralium, which takes inspiration from the seemingly infinite array of shapes and colours that teem with life in a coral reef.

Our young founder, Eliza Walter, says "Imperfect Treasures and Corralium are only the beginning, as Lylie's will be launching mini-collections around different themes every few months. We are extremely excited to open this online shop and share a new approach to jewellery."
