KNITTED TERRARIUM HANGER

PATTERN:

KNITTED TERRARIUM HANGER

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

6" / 15 CM DIAMETER 3" / 7.5 CM TALL

NOTES:

- » Knit in the round on double-pointed needles.
- » 4 repeats of Lace Pattern worked in each round.

YARN:

Approximately 50 yds / 46 m of natural cooking twine

NEEDLES:

US size 8 / 5 mm: 1 set of double-pointed needles

NOTIONS:

- » Tapestry needle
- » Stitch markers
- » 6"-Round glass bowl
- » Small Rocks
- » Cactus planting mix
- » Cacti & succulents
- » 4 Clips or clothes pins
- » 11/4" Metal ring





KNITTED TERRARIUM HANGER

INSTRUCTIONS:

PATTERN STITCH

Lace Pattern (worked over 3-17 sts per rep)

Rnds 1 - 2: Knit. (3 sts)

Rnd 3: (Kl, yo) twice, kl. (5 sts)

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: Kl, yo, k3, yo, kl. (7 sts)

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: Kl, yo, k5, yo, kl. (9 sts)

Rnd 8: K3, yo, sl2, kl, p2sso, yo, k3.

Rnd 9: Kl, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, yo, kl. (11 sts)

Rnd 10: K2, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k2.

Rnd 11: Kl, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, k1. (13 sts)

Rnd 12: K5, yo, sl2, kl, p2sso, yo, k5.

Rnd 13: Kl, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2, yo, kl.

Rnd 14: Kl, k2tog, yo, kl, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, kl, yo, ssk, kl.

Rnd 15: K2, yo, k3, yo, ssk, kl, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2. (17 sts)

Rnd 16: Kl, yo, ssk, k4, yo, sl2, kl, p2sso, yo, k4,

k2tog, yo, kl. Round 17: K2, yo, ssk, kl, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, kl,

k2tog, yo, k2. Rnd 18: K3, yo, sl2, kl, p2sso, yo, k5, yo, sl2, kl,

p2sso, yo, k3.

Rnd 19: (Kl, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk) twice, kl.

Rnds 20 - 23: Repeat Rnds 16 - 19.

Hanger

Cut 4 - 3 1/2 yd / 3.2 m strings for hanging straps,

CO 12 sts, dividing evenly between 4 dpn's.

Mark beg of rnd and join, taking care not to twist

Work 4 rep's of Lace Pattern (1 rep per each needle), Rnds 1-23.

Do not BO.

Thread one 3 1/2 yd string onto a tapestry needle and fold in half. Run tapestry needle through 17 sts on one dpn, centering the stitches on the the string. Rep with remaining 3 strings and dpn's. Cut tail of working yarn same length as adjacent group of strings.







INSTRUCTIONS:

FASTENING STRING SECTIONS: 1. Place bowl in center of hanger. You will now have 7 groups of 2 strings and one group of 3 strings.



3. Turn bowl and rep Step 2.



5. After last section is attached to bowl, tie a knot with the two string sections at each clip.



2. Working with the strings of two opposite sections of stitches, pull strings so they are centered and clip onto bowl.



4. Turn bowl and rep Step 2.









INSTRUCTIONS:

TYING THE HOOK: 1. Gather 4 string sections so they are equal length and thread through ring. (This is easier to do if you have someone else holding the ring)



3. Wrap ends up and pull through loop made with fingers.



2. Wrap ends all the way around 4 string sections counter-clockwise.



4. Pull ends through.







INSTRUCTIONS:



6. Trim ends as desired.



5. Pull ends tight, forming a slip knot.







INSTRUCTIONS:

HOW TO MAKE A TERRARIUM: 1. Clean glass bowl.



3. Place soil or cactus mix on top.



5. Place terrarium in hanger and enjoy!



2. Place a layer of small rocks in the base to ensure drainage.



4. Plant succulents. Use small tongs to place cacti.



ssk	slip 2 stitches individually as if to knit, then knit those 2 stitches together through the back loops (left-slanting decrease)
