

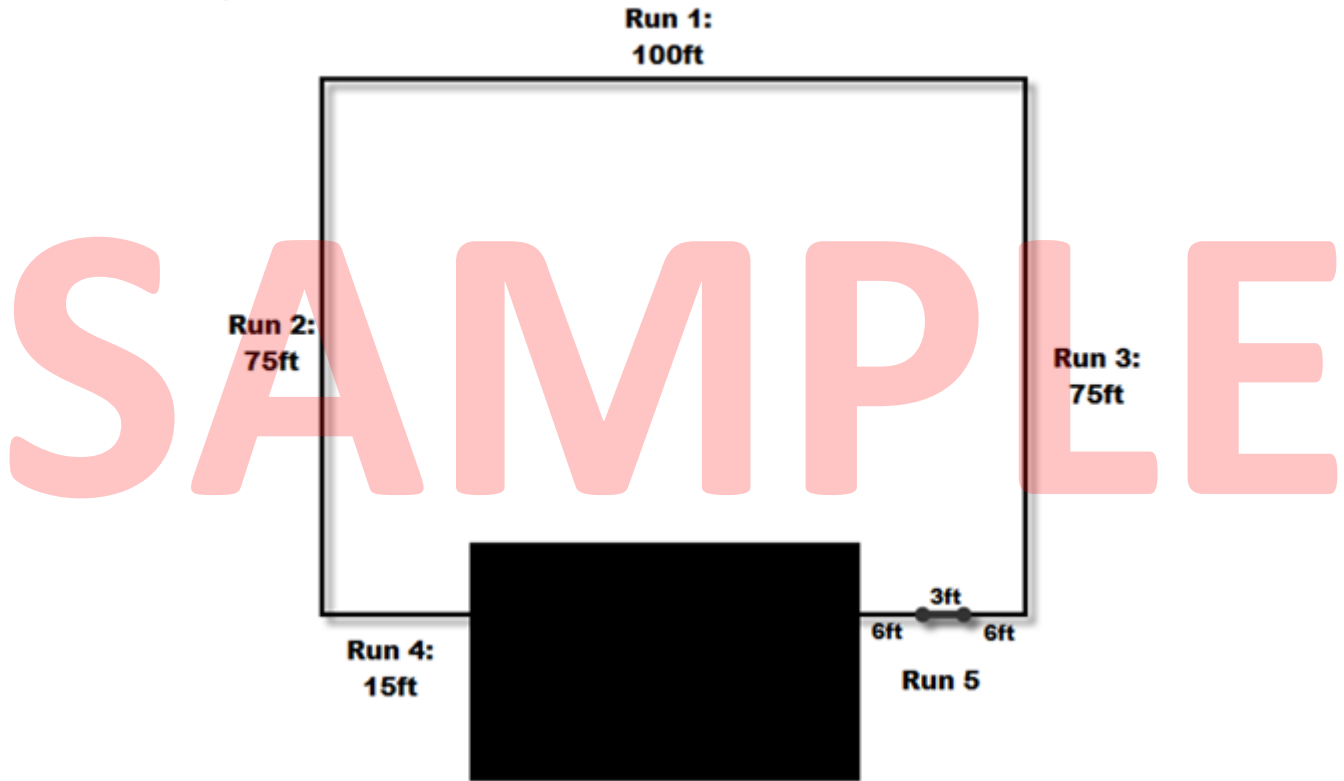
TIPS:

- Each roller is 4ft long in length, there will be some rollers that will need to be cut. For example: A roller cut may be required at a corner or due to a fence post in the way of installing a bracket.
- The total number of Rollers needed is the total length of your entire fence divided by 4ft. Include any extra needed due to cuts required (this is typically 1-2 extra rollers per fence)
- If your job requires cutting, you will likely need extra End Caps. For example: if you were to cut one 4ft roller into 2ft halves, you would need 2 additional End Caps for one of the halves. Rollers come with End Caps preinstalled. Be sure to see the Installation Guide on cutting Rollers and removing/inserting End Caps.
- As a general rule of thumb, to determine the total number of Brackets needed, multiply the number of rollers by 1.25 to determine the number of brackets you need. Be sure to order the correct bracket type for your fence.
