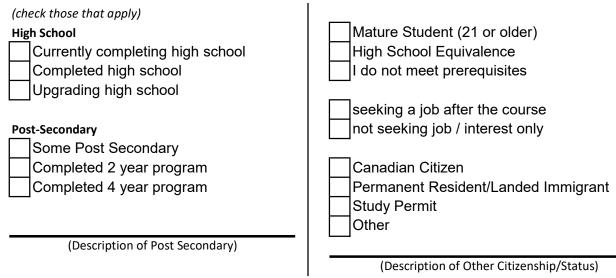

Program Fees

Upon offer and acceptance of Admission, and signing of Admission Contract (issued separately) there is a non-refundable admission deposit of \$500. Upon the start of the course the deposit is credited to your tuition. \$5,200 (ie \$5,700 - 500 deposit) is due at the start of the course. The balance (\$3,800) is due at the end of week 4. Refunds: Withdrawals within the first 6 full days (ie 10% of the course) pay in total 25% of the tuition (ie \$2,375. We will refund 5700-2375 = \$3,325 plus the second payment (\$3,800) if it has already been made). Withdrawals between the 7th and 30th full day pay in total 60% of the course (ie \$5,700. If the second payment has already been made we will refund the \$3,800 second payment in full). Withdrawals after 6 weeks (50% of the course or 30 full program days) receive no refund.
