

## SHERMAN the SHEEP



## YOU WILL NEED:

Amaretti biscuits

small white marshmallows

600d quality white chocolate

600d quality milk or dark chocolate

A sheet of acetate (or other clear plastic)

Piping bags

melt your chocolate gently in the microwave in short bursts of 10-20 seconds, stirring well after each burst. this will mean the temperature doesn't get too high and it will both keep its shape better when piped and set your pieces together faster.

when you are ready to use it - Put your Plastic Piping bag inside a cup and fold the edges over the Rim of the cup - you can then easily fill the bag with your chocolate and then twist the end of the bag to secure it. snip the tip of the Piping bag off when you're ready to pipe.

(if you don't have a Plastic PiPing bag then google 'greaseproof Paper PiPing bag'... they're very easy to make)



start by PiPing the white chocolate roughly over the backs of the amaretti biscuits to make them look woolly

You'll need 2 biscuits PER Sheep



when you've finished they should look something like this

LEAVE them to set - if you are impatient like me then you can put them in the fridge for a few minutes to speed this up

once the chocolate has set, turn the biscuits upside down, pipe a ring of chocolate around the edge and stick a row of white marshmallows into it (flat sides facing outwards)





once you have your circle of marshmallows, PiPE a little chocolate into the centre and fill with marshmallows

once this has set, stick another layer of marshmallows on top of the layer you have already made, Plus Put a single layer onto your second woolly biscuit





once the biscuits have set, Pipe a little chocolate onto one of the sides and stick them together to form the body of the sheep.

Leave to set (with something to support the sides and keep the shape if you need to)

once its set, take four marshmallows, pipe a little chocolate onto the top of each one and stick the body of the sheep to the tops of its new leas





GIVE YOUR SHEEP a tail!

using the sheep head template at end of this document as a guide... cover it with a sheet of acetate, melt your milk or dark chocoolate and pipe as many sheeps heads as you need and leave to set





Give him a white chocolate Fringe by PiPing some dots (do two layers if He needs some extra volume)

once the heads have set, peel them off the acetate and stick them to the body of the sheep with some more melted chocolate
