
## Fingering chart for D, C and G Tabor Pipes



- Finger hole closed
- Finger hole open
- Finger hole half closed

## Note:

- 1. The first four low notes are not usually used. So blow a bit harder for the usual starting note. Each time you lift all fingers, put them on again and blow harder to work your way up the scale. You have to get used to both the fingering and the amount of breath pressure required to get the note you want!
- 2. I have used 8ve and 15<sup>th</sup> clefs to indicate the actual pitch so that the notes appear in a range most useful for tunes.
