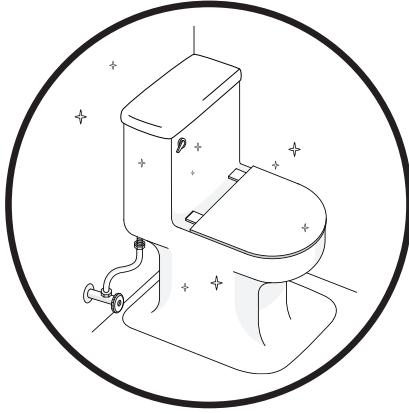


Patience

Say out loud:

**"Righty-tighty,
aka clockwise.
Lefty-loosey aka
counterclockwise."**

Step 1

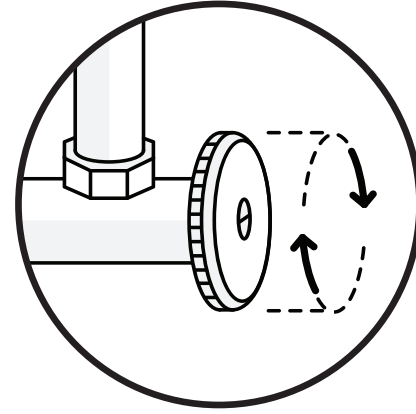


Clean toilet.

You don't wanna be face-to-face with a dirty toilet bowl.

We won't be taking the seat off until Step 11.

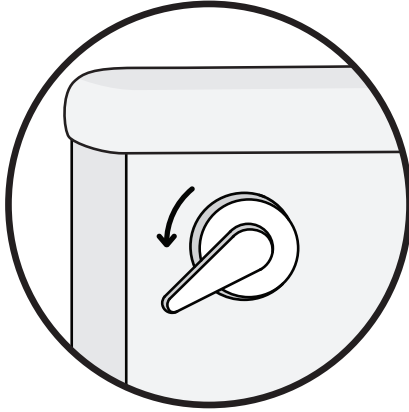
Step 2



Carefully turn water supply off.

Find the water supply on the wall near your toilet and slowly turn the water valve clockwise until you can't turn it anymore.

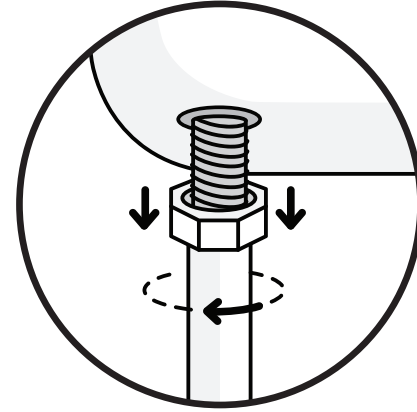
Step 3



Flush toilet.

Hold toilet handle down for 10 seconds to empty as much water from the tank as possible.

Step 4



Unscrew water supply hose from toilet tank.

Expect a small amount of water remaining in the hose to spill out.

Important Interruption

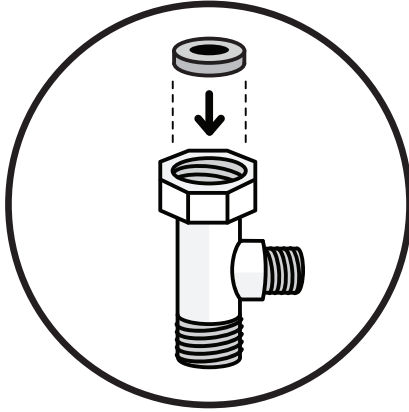
Over the next several steps, make sure you screw everything on straight and even to prevent damage to parts and leaking.

Another Important Interruption

Tighten connections with hand power. If a tool is needed, tighten in increments of less than a quarter rotation.

Overtightening can damage parts and cause leaking.

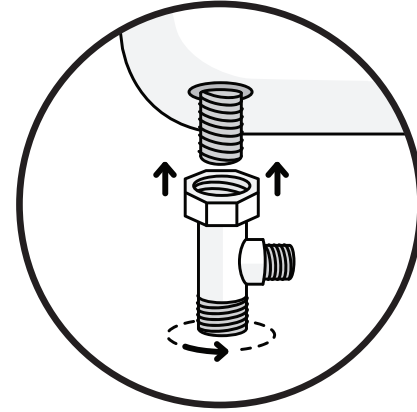
Step 5



**Place washer
inside T-adapter.**

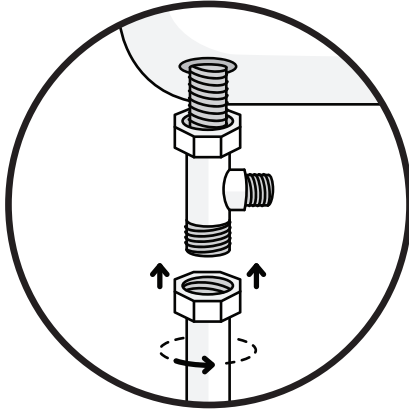
The washer may already be inside the T-adapter.
Either way, make sure it's completely at the bottom
of the T-adapter.

Step 6



**Screw T-adapter to
toilet tank water inlet.**

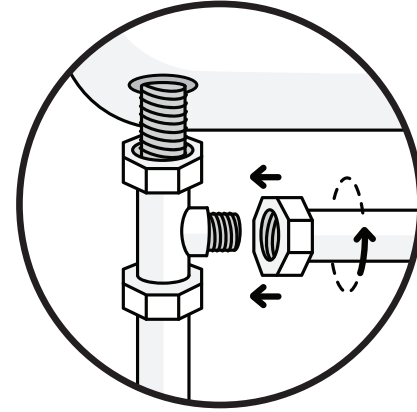
Step 7



Screw water supply hose to T-adapter.

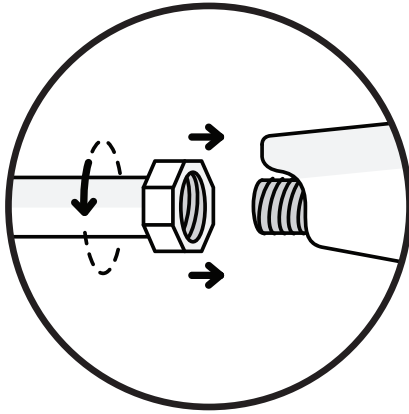
The hose coming from the water supply, not the included hose.

Step 8



Screw included hose to T-adapter.

Step 9



**Screw included
hose to Whisper
water inlet.**

Step 10

The moment of truth. Test for leaks.

Set Whisper on toilet with nozzle in bowl. Slowly turn water supply on the wall counterclockwise until water is flowing.

Check all connection points. If there are leaks, turn water supply off and go to page 28.

If there are no leaks, slowly turn the water flow knob on your Whisper toward "NOZZLE." This should shoot water straight into toilet. If there are no leaks, turn your Whisper off and proceed to the next step!

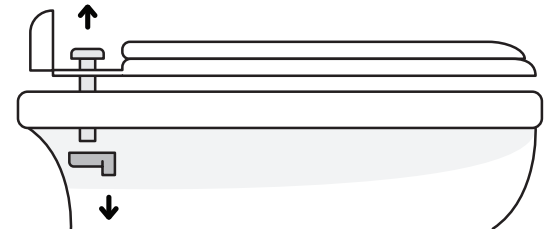
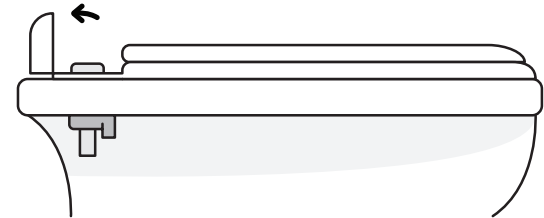
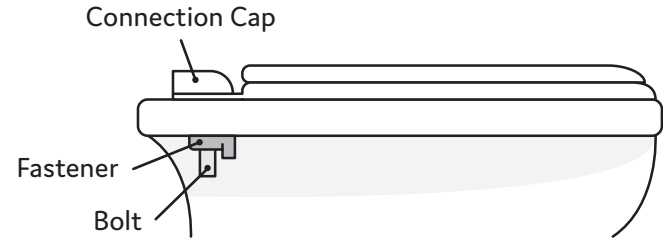
Step 11

Remove toilet seat.

Set Whisper aside. Flip seat connection caps up by hand or with flathead screwdriver.

To unscrew the bolt, you'll need to reach to the underside of the seat connection with your other hand and spin off the seat fasteners while pressing down on the bolt heads, or hold the seat fasteners in place and unscrew the bolt heads.

You'll want to do some further cleaning now that the toilet seat is removed.



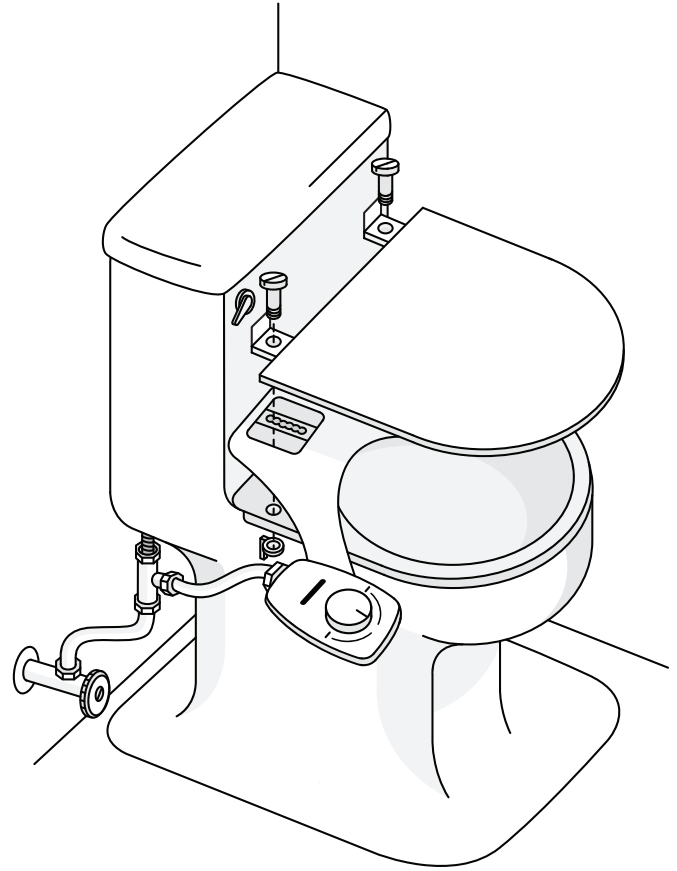
Step 12

Align Whisper and reattach seat.

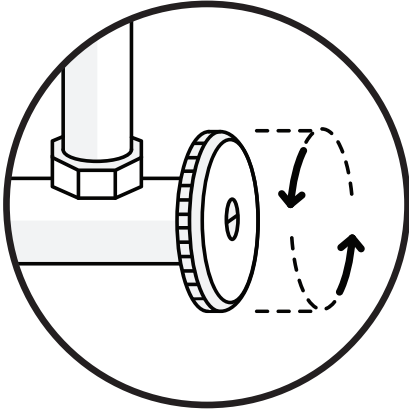
Place Whisper on toilet. Adjust seat hooks so they align with seat bolt holes on toilet.

Place toilet seat on top and thread the seat bolts through everything. Reattach seat fasteners. As you tighten the seat back into place make sure everything is straight and the nozzle is centered in the toilet bowl.

If your toilet seat does not lay flat after adding Whisper take the toilet seat off, add one of the included spacers on top of each mounting bracket, place your toilet seat back on top, and rethread the seat bolts through everything. Add additional spacers if needed. In the unlikely case, your toilet seat still has a small gap you may require seat bumpers available from your local hardware store. Step 13



Congratulations!

You just leveled up your bathroom game.

Turn water supply on.

Slowly turn the water supply valve
counterclockwise until it's all the way on.

Using your Whisper for the first time:

1. Drop a duce

Ahh, that's better.

2. Rinse clean

Very slowly turn the pressure control knob toward "REAR" until the water pressure is comfortable for you. Rinse for 10-20 seconds and do a little wiggle and maybe a little tension release to ensure you rinse every crevice in your cranny (just the outside though).

3. Dry & post-wipe-check

Dab yourself dry and confirm you removed all the dirty bits with a post-wipe-check using the same TP from the drying if possible. You should be clean. If not, make sure you've properly positioned your bullseye into the crosshair, rinse, and repeat.

****Some people rinse and dab dry with a cloth towel, using no toilet paper.****

More Advice

Toilet paper.

Now that you'll be using just a few squares of toilet paper, it's recommended you use strong toilet paper instead of one-ply.

One-ply falls apart too easily when in contact with water. If you have strong toilet paper, you can do your post-wipe with the same paper you dab dry with.

What to do if there's a leak:

1. Take a deep breath.
2. Determine exactly where the leak is coming from.
3. Refer to the next page to solve leak.

****When testing leaks, you need to turn the water supply valve on only a little bit and then turn it back off.****

Washers

Make sure you used the provided washer and replace any old defective washers you already had.

Straight Connections

Get eye level and make sure you screwed connections on perfectly straight. Screwing parts on crookedly can damage them and cause leaks.

Tighten Connections

Make sure connections are tight, but not overtightened. Overtightening can damage parts and cause leaks. When tightening with a wrench, tighten with a quarter rotation at a time.

Worn Threads

Old, worn out, threads on your toilet tank water inlet may require some 'plumber's tape' (available at your local hardware store) wrapped around the threads to insure an air tight seal.

If you've checked all your connections and washers and threads and the problem still exists, check everything again.

We know it can be maddening, but leaks are often caused by a bad or missing washer or a poorly screwed connection.
