50 016 poppy oil

product name:

Poppy oil.

ingredients:

• Poppy oil.

basic information:

• Especially refined (bleached) poppy oil.

characteristics:

- Pure
- light.

handling:

- Binding component for oil colours and oil painting mediums.
- Binder for own production of white oil colours. (The mixing ratio of binder to pigment very much depends on the type of pigment. Pre-test!)
- Attention: *Poppy oil* should only be used sparingly and always in combination with *sunflower oil* or *linseed oil*!
- The product dries slower than linseed oil, purified, 50015.
- The product shoes a lower tendency to yellow than linseed oil, purified, 50015.
- The product is ready to use, but can be diluted with e.g. turpentine substitute 50019.
- Please clean tools like brushes or palettes as soon as possible with e.g. oil turpentine 50024 / 50102, turpentine substitute 50019 or brush cleaner 50051 / 50052.
- Close immediately after use.
- Store in a cool and dry place.
- Individual pre-tests are required (see footer).

General hints for working with drying vegetable oils:

- Colours with a binder based on vegetable oils show a tendency for yellowing specially in the dark.
- Materials such as cleaning rags, paper wipes and protective clothing, which are contaminated with
 the product may spontaneously self-ignite some hours later. To avoid the risk of fires, all
 contaminated materials should be placed in a close metal container soaked with water or washed
 out well with warm soapy water before disposal. Contaminated materials should be removed from
 the workplace at the end of each working day and be stored outside.
