2002 The Factor

Our homage to the great old vines of the Barossa Valley, this wine is composed of 100% Shiraz.

Complex and concentrated, the wine is cloaked in velvet tannins that will continue to develop for another 10 years at least. The Factor is all that you would expect of a pureblood Barossa Shiraz.

The manager on a highland estate is referred to as The Factor. Having spent two years in predominantly older oak, this wine manages to express true Barossa Shiraz character

2002 THE FACTOR

VARIETAL: 100% Shiraz

REGIONS: Marananga, Koonunga Hill, Moppa, Gomersal

HARVEST: Mid April 2002

pH: 3.58

ACID: 6.22 g/L

ALCOHOL: 14.5% Alc/Vol

VINIFICATION: Small parcels of fruit from old dry grown vines are selected for their individual qualities and matured separately in old 70% and new 30% French Oak barriques for 24 months.
