2005 Saignée Rose

The 2005 Saignée Rose, the first release of this wine, appears a clean salmon colour as it is poured into the glass, with a light terracotta tinge. The fragrant nose of ripe red cherries, orange rind, spice and earth immediately entice the drinker, and display how good Mataro Rose can be. The bright red fruits are carried over onto the palate and a crisp yet rich, lush finish complete this Rose's flavour profile.

HARVEST: May 2005

pH: 3.45

ACID: 5.63 g/L

ALCOHOL: 14.5% Alc/Vol

OAK TREATMENT: 6 months in seasoned French oak.
