VARIETAL: 59% Grenache, 22% Shiraz & 19% Mataro

REGIONS: Gomersal, Seppeltsfield, Marananga, Moppa, Greenock & Ebenezer  
(40 – 150 year old vines)

HARVEST: April 2013

pH: 3.58

ACID: 5.21g/L

ALCOHOL: 15.03% Alc/Vol

VINIFICATION:

Fermented in single vineyard batches, assembled in tank and allowed to complete a natural malo-lactic fermentation before being bottled without filtration or fining in October 2014.
