

CONCORDIS is a collaborative winemaking project that unites Barossa Valley producers, Kaesler Wines, Seppeltsfield Winery, Torbreck Vintners, and Two Hands Wines to create a unique cuvée from one tonne of their finest Shiraz grapes each vintage.

The purpose of the initiative is to give back to the region that has been so supportive of the four wineries, with the aim to raise more than \$700,000 over the initial four years with all proceeds going to a perpetual education fund through Foundation Barossa.

The fund will then provide ongoing financial support and training opportunities in cellar operations and viticulture for financially disadvantaged, local young people, through two-year traineeships being offered at each of the wineries.

With only 1,600 magnums made annually, CONCORDIS is the perfect collector's item.

## VINTAGE 2015

Deep crimson red in colour with a ruby hue. Bright and lifted aromas of red and purple berry fruit, peppered with brown spice notes of nutmeg and cinnamon with a whisper of fresh vanilla bean pod. On the palate, this medium bodied wine is lively with vivacious juicy acidity. The fruit component of raspberry, red currant and boysenberry is fresh and generous, supported by stylish French oak. The wine has great drive and a backbone of chamois like tannins contributing to the length and vibrancy.

## VINIFICATION

On Monday the 23rd February 2015, Kaesler Wines, Seppeltsfield Winery, Torbreck Vintners and Two Hands Wines, harvested small parcels of shiraz from each of our Estate owned vineyards:

Kaesler Wines: 1140kg from Alte Reben Vineyard, Jenke Road, Seppeltsfield Seppeltsfield Winery: 1160kg from Wazza's Block, Seppeltsfield Road, Seppeltsfield Torbreck Vintners: 1069kg from Descendant Vineyard, Roennfeldt Road, Marananga Two Hands Wines: 1013kg from Kraehe House Block, Neldner Road, Marananga

Hand harvested to maintain fruit freshness, the 2015 CONCORDIS spent 8 days on skins in an open fermenter in the Seppeltsfield gravity winery and was the matured for 14 months in French oak hogsheads, four of which were new.

United for a great cause, each of the four wineries has 400 magnums to sell annually.
