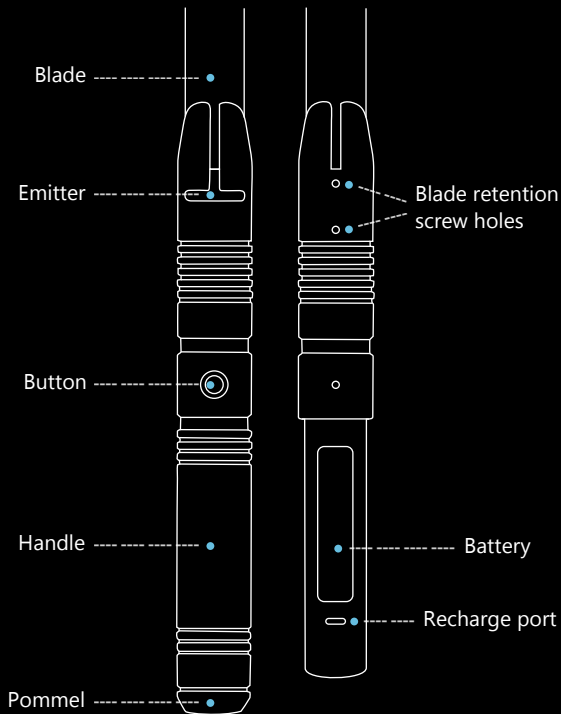

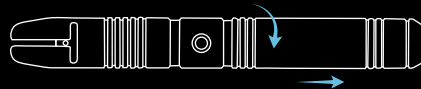

▶ ILLUSTRATION OF MODEL

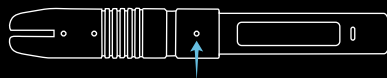


▶ DISMANTLING

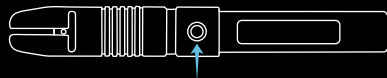
- ① Rotate and unscrew the lightsaber body



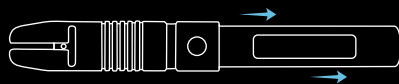
- ② Unscrew the back screws of the handle



- ③ Push the switch button from the handle surface into the infrastructure

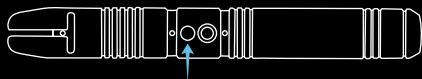


- ④ Pull down the inner structure

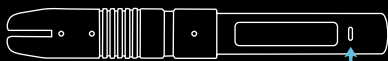


▶ CHARGING DIAGRAM

- ① For models with an external charging port, please use the charging cable provided by the merchant to plug in and charge.



- ② For models with built-in charging port, please unscrew the saber pommel or handle, and then use the charging cable provided by the merchant to plug in and charge.



- ③ For models without a charging port, please unscrew the saber handle, then take out the battery and use the charging box provided by the merchant to charge.

▶ SECURITY INFORMATION

Before using and operating the product, in order to ensure optimal product performance and avoid dangerous or illegal situations, please read and follow all safety information.

① Operation and Safety

- Please fully charge before operation.
- Please use a 5V1A power adapter.
- Please keep small accessories safe and keep them out of reach of children to prevent them from accidentally swallowing.
- Please notice the anode and cathode of the battery.
- Please use this product within the temperature range of 0C~35C and store it in the range of -20C~+45C.
- Don't expose the battery to high temperatures or heat generating products, such as sunlight, heaters, microwaves, ovens, or water heaters. Overheating the battery may cause an explosion.
- Don't throw batteries into fire. It is prohibited to disassemble, drop, squeeze or modify batteries. Avoid foreign objects inserting, puncturing the battery, or immersing the battery in water or other liquids. Avoid external shocks and pressure on the battery. To prevent battery leakage, overheating, fire or explosion.
- Please dispose of batteries according to local regulations and don't dispose of them as household waste. Improper disposal of batteries may lead to battery explosions.

▶ FAQ

① The saber has no sound

Please confirm whether it is in mute mode, and you can adjust volume mode, or reinstall the battery.

② The blade is easy to loosen

Make sure that the screws that secure the blade are tightened. In addition, it is normal for the screws and the blade to loosen during the fight. You can change the fixed position of the screw and tighten the screw.

③ Saber cannot be turned on

Please charge the saber first to make sure it is fully charged. If it still can't be solved, please remove the battery and reinstall it (pay attention to the positive and negative poles), and make sure the battery are contact well.

▶ WARRANTY

The product has a one-year warranty period.

Warranty covers original products and accessories that have not been modified.

Includes: light saber handle, electronic internal structure, and light saber blade.
